



Soft Infant & Toddler Carrier Safety Tips

- When choosing a carrier, **purchase from a reputable retailer and look for products with a tracking label** (name of manufacturer, location, model name/number).
- **Purchase new if possible**, rather than secondhand, to ensure the carrier is in working condition and meets latest federal standards.
- **Ensure that the carrier fits the wearer** (the caregiver) and is adjusted for a comfortable, secure fit before placing an infant in the carrier.
- Caregivers should check buckles, straps, rings and other hardware to **make sure no parts are broken**.
- **Follow all manufacturer's instructions** and warnings including appropriate age/weight recommendations.
