ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT

After reviewing the Order on Motion to Dismiss and Motion for Summary Decision, the Order on Summary Decision Motions, and the Initial Decision and Order on Remedies entered in this case, as well as the Appeal Briefs, Answering Briefs, and Reply Briefs, the Commission has determined that oral argument is appropriate to emphasize and clarify the issues raised in this matter. 16 C.F.R. § 1025.53(g). Accordingly, oral argument will occur on Thursday, December 14, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Hearing Room 420 of the Headquarters Building of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, located at Bethesda Towers, 4330 East West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland, 20814.

Each party will be allotted forty-five minutes to present its argument. Respondent Amazon.com, Inc. will have the opportunity to open the argument and will be permitted to reserve up to fifteen minutes for rebuttal. Either party may provide the Commission with a short written or electronic compilation of material, or make use of appropriate visual aids, to facilitate its presentation during the oral argument. Such material or visual aids must contain only public information that is already in the record of the proceeding. Each party shall file such material or visual aids with the Commission, and provide copies to opposing counsel, no later than December 7, 2023.
