

Order Granting Extensions

The parties jointly moved for an extension of time to file motions to compel discovery. Good cause has been shown, and the motions to compel, if necessary, shall be due August 30, 2018.

After further review of the Consumer Product Safety Commission's rules of practice, I note that my written response to Respondent Britax Child Safety's motion for disqualification is due ten days after the filing of the motion—August 13, 2018. 16 C.F.R. § 1025.42(e)(2). I find the same good cause to extend this deadline as well. Complaint Counsel's response to this motion, if any, remains due by August 17, 2018, although under the circumstances I will entertain motions to extend that deadline. I presently intend to file my written response by August 30, 2018.
