

Letter to International Code Council on Scope of Wired Glass Exemption in 16 C.F.R. Part 1201
(Briefing package dated May 10, 2004, OS No. 4808)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to issue the letter as drafted. The letter drafted by the Office of the General Counsel is an advisory opinion letter to the International Code Council to inform it of the scope of, and requirements associated with the exemption of wired glass from the otherwise applicable requirements of the Commission's safety standard for architectural glazing materials that appears in 16 C.F.R. Part 1201(c)(1). The International Code Council is responsible for developing model building codes that are then adopted as mandatory requirements by many jurisdictions in the United States. The advisory opinion letter would assist the International Building Code Structural Committee in its deliberations at the Spring 2004 International code Council meeting (on May 16-20, 2004) on issues related to use of wired glass in building construction.
