


While we and our advisors, however, still feel that the previously agreed upon labels would be more effective, we will go along with the Commission's wishes to show good faith.

Thank you for taking time with me on the telephone yesterday.

We regret, and apologize for the delay in implementation of up-graded warning labels on our Aqua Sling water balloon sling shot game.

Riva Sport is a sheltered workshop employing the handicapped. I am the only formal employee of Riva Sport, but I have 300 handicapped workers under contract.

We apparently misunderstood the communications between ourselves, the Jenner & Block law firm, and your Commission, and thus caused some unnecessary delay in the process. We did, however, do our best under the circumstances.

I have enclosed communications depicting the sequence of events in this matter. It is our understanding from these letters that our company and the Commission concluded an agreement concerning the up-graded labels, and with which we have complied to the best of our ability.

Based on this agreement, and assurances by Jenner & Block, we have spent over \$8,000 printing and installing new labels and package insert cards, as well as additional warnings inside the balloon bag in the package.

We agree on the potential benefit to all from these up-grades, but we have already spent over \$20,000 on this matter. As our company mission is to employ and train the handicapped, and not to get rich (we have not had a net profit in over 7 years, nor have I drawn a salary in this time), you can see what a burden this has been, considering that we had very explicit, legible, and redundant warnings to start with.

We received your FAX depicting a copy of our competitor's warning label. Compared to the labels and warnings we have installed, according to our prior agreement with the Commission, we are concerned that this competitor's label will be ineffective. Bad grammar aside, its text is confusing and inconclusive, and its colors are not current safety industry standard for eye-catching and impact.

In addition, the questions of availability to viewer, durability, and redundancy of exposure all arise. Our product and its packaging, however, is literally covered with cautions, warnings, and directions, and it has been since day one.

We are grateful to the Commission for its input and assistance in improving our product, and helping to minimize potential problems.

We do, however, feel that we had an agreement with the Commission, which we fulfilled to the best of our ability, and at great expense.

We have no reservations about further improving our product labeling, as long as it is an actual improvement. We do think some consideration should be given to us for the substantial sums we have readily spent in compliance with our agreement, and for our obvious good faith and efforts toward safety, both recently and in our past product history.

At your convenience, please let us know the thoughts of the Commission. We are more than agreeable to any effective labeling improvements.



You will find new warnings on the lower-front on the insert card, on the back of the insert card, in the 'balloon bag' inside the package, and on the label securely sewn to the black pouch of the product itself.

I apologize for the delay in making these improvements, but in addition to all of us here being physically impaired, both our printer and our label-maker were asked to re-do their originally-submitted work as we felt it was not of high quality. Cumulatively these added up to unforeseen and regrettable delays, but we delayed shipments until we were satisfied with the final, improved product which you will find in this package.

We have not received any more notices of injury or dissatisfaction with this product since Brock Landry brought you current with those we had received in the past. We will continue to inform your commission of any complaints or inquiries we receive in the future.

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
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

Dear Mr. Jacobs:

This responds to your November 2, 1995 letter regarding the label your firm intends to attach to each Riva Aqua Sling water balloon slingshot.

As we discussed by telephone, you accepted the CPSC staff's recommended text to revise your label. The label that you faxed to me on November 2, 1995 is as we agreed to in regards to the warning sign, the letter size and the text. Also we agreed that the label would be 4" by 1 3/8" and sewn down on both ends so as to be clearly visible to users at all times.

The Commission staff appreciates your cooperation in addressing the issue of serious injuries occurring with water balloon slingshots. The staff has accepted your firm's voluntary corrective action plan as adequate. As a corrective action, the labeling on the slingshot pouches and on the product packaging is intended to prevent further eye, face or other serious injuries in the future. Should future evidence show that these actions are inadequate, the Commission will revisit this issue with your firm.

The firm has a continuing obligation to inform the Commission of any and all defects associated with this product which could create a substantial product hazard and of information which reasonably supports the conclusion that the product creates an unreasonable risk of serious injury or death. If the firm receives any information that affects the scope, prevalence, or seriousness of the defect or hazard we are addressing, you must immediately report that information to the Division of Corrective Actions pursuant to section 15(b) of the CPSA.

The Commission publishes a list of product recalls and other corrective actions initiated by firms in an Annual Report to



Congress. This information is also occasionally used in lists for specific product categories. A summary of the firm's corrective action is enclosed. Because the corrective action is being taken voluntarily and in the absence of a preliminary staff determination that this product presents a substantial hazard, the firm's agreement to include its corrective action in Commission publications is purely voluntary on the firm's part. Unless the firm notifies the staff by telephone or letter within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, the staff will assume the information in the enclosed summary is accurate and the firm does not object to its publication.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. We hope that future dealings between the company and the Division of Corrective Actions, should they become necessary, will be conducted in the same spirit.


