Subject: Interagency Agreement Number CPSC-IAG-74-25, Task Order No. 98-1 (98-1153)

The Consumer Product Safety Commission will reimburse funds to the National Institute of Standards and Technology for the purpose of accomplishing the work as set forth in the attached Statement of Work under Task Order No. 98-1, during Fiscal Year 1998 .

I. Contents of Task Order

- A. Summary of Project Total: Support of CPSC Technical Activities \$2,000.
- B. Provisions: The following provisions contained in Interagency Agreement number CPSC-IAG-74-25, Supplement Agreement No. 14, apply to this Task Order.
 - 1. Routing Correspondence!
 - 2. Billing Arrangements*
 - 3. Description of Reporting Requirements
 - 4. Identification of CPSC Property
 - 5. Authority

*The NIST Technical Unit will notify the CPSC Liaison Officer in writing when 80% of the CPSC Project funds are expended for this Task Order.

All other provisions are contained in the following Statement of Work.

II. BACKGROUND

Section 29(d) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA), directs the CPSC, to the maximum extent practicable, to utilize the resources and facilities of the NIST to perform research and analyses related to risks of injury associated with consumer products (including fire and flammability risks), to develop test methods, to conduct studies and investigations, and to provide technical advice and assistance in connection with the function of the CPSC. The support work outlined below will allow the CPSC Laboratory Sciences, Engineering Laboratory (LSE) to carry out its obligations in areas of regulation development and compliance and enforcement.

III. SPECIFICATIONS

NIST shall perform the following tasks:

- A. Provide general laboratory support to supplement LSE's capabilities for compliance and enforcement efforts as well as regulation development. This support includes:
 - 1. Performance of specialized tests and/or providing facilities when the CPSC engineering Laboratory does not have the capability, or if it would be impractical to establish such capability.
 - 2. Various shop (machine, wood, etc.) support for the development and production of test fixtures or specialized test equipment.
- B. The above work will be initiated on a sub-task order basis, in writing, by the CPSC Liaison Officer, Robert T. Garrett or George Sushinsky LSE. Each sub-task will have a completion date and will be monitored periodically by the CPSC Liaison Officer.
- C. Upon receipt of a sub-task request from CPSC, NIST shall provide the CPSC Liaison Officer a moderately detailed proposal which shall include a description of shop(s) (machine, wood, etc.) to be involved and the work to be performed in that shop, a description of the specialized test(s) to be performed, a description of material required, the period of performance of the sub-task and cost broken out by the following criteria:
 - 1. Material
 - 2. Labor category, number of hours & total labor costs.
 - 3. Overhead/indirect costs (if any)
- D. Upon approval by the Contracting Officer, the sub-task will be issued.

IV. BILLING REQUIREMENTS

The NIST Comptroller's Office shall submit quarterly requests/financial reports for payment to CPSC by sub-task order. These requests/financial reports shall be forwarded to the CPSC Finance Branch for payment at the following address:
