



Dear Mr. Cantor:

Thank you for your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request seeking information from the Commission. The remaining records from the Commission files responsive to your request have been processed and copies of the releasable responsive records are enclosed. The enclosed records constitute forty-nine Epidemiologic Investigation Reports with the underlying and supporting documentation and related product complaints or reported incidents where available. The Commission has received this information from its formal investigation systems. Through these systems the Commission hopes to learn when specific products are associated with illness, injury or death. The Commission believes that it has taken reasonable steps to assure the accuracy of this information. While conducting the interviews for the investigation reports, Commission staff or contractors have spoken with the individuals involved or with others who witnessed or are familiar with the incidents. Where possible, Commission staff have examined the products reportedly involved in the incidents. Although the Commission has investigated the incidents described in the investigation reports, the Commission has not necessarily determined the cause of the incidents.

The Commission's FOIA regulations at 16 C.F.R. § 1015.9, provide for the charging of fees resulting from the processing of FOIA requests. The processing of your request involved: (1) the duplication of 1,500 pages X \$0.10/page = \$150.00; and (2) review time to determine whether records were permitted to be withheld, 4 hours X \$19.60/hour = \$78.40. Forward the total amount due, **\$228.40**, by check or money order made payable to the **TREASURY OF THE UNITED STATES** with the enclosed copy

of this letter to: **Division of Financial Services, ADFS Room 522, U.S. CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION, Washington, D. C. 20207.**

Note that after thirty days interest will be charged on amounts billed. Furthermore, if billing is not paid in a timely manner the Commission will require advance payment for your future requests and any pending requests.

The Commission's Freedom of Information Officer, Office of the Secretary, will consider written request for a waiver of the assessed fees when the requester can show that disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government and disclosure of the requested information is not primarily in the commercial interest of the requester. Other factors to be considered are listed in the regulations at 16 C.F.R. § 1015.9(f)(5).

You will note that in the documents disclosed information that could identify injured parties and persons treating them has been deleted, because section 25(c) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2074(c)(1), prohibits such disclosures without the consent of those individuals. In some cases the parties have denied consent or consent has not otherwise been obtained.

We will contact you as we complete the processing of the remaining materials. Thank you for your interest in consumer product safety.

The information contained in this report was obtained from a report prepared by the Hemet Police Department(A). The investigator for the Riverside County Coroner's office was also interviewed.

An unsuccessful attempt was made to contact the victim's mother while in Hemet, CA. The identity of the victim's family had been purged from the death certificate which was attached to the assignment message. It was not possible, therefore, to attempt to contact the victim's family before a visit was made to Hemet, CA and a copy of the police report, which identified the family, was obtained.

PRE EVENT

The victim was a 9 month old female who lived with her parents and 4 year old sister in a single family residence.

The victim's mother bathed both of the girls in the bathtub of the residence. They were bathed together.

Two months before the event the victim and her sister were left alone in the tub by their mother for 2-3 minutes. The victim was in the bathtub seat. When the mother returned she found the victim under the water. She picked her up and shook her. Water came out of her mouth, and she coughed. She then started breathing normally.

The 4 year old sister can take care of herself in the tub. The victim was learning to stand and needed to be watched.

On the day of the event the victim's mother was bathing the two girls as usual. She placed 8-10 inches of water in the tub. The victim was placed in the bathtub seat which was fastened to the bottom of the tub by suction cups. The victim was not supposed to be able to get out of the seat. The victim's mother began bathing the girls.

A family friend was using the telephone in the victim's residence. He was talking to his wife. The victim's mother reported that the conversation was getting loud due to shouting over the phone. She left the bathroom to ask the friend to be quiet because he was alarming the girls.

EVENT

After the victim's mother had been away from the bathroom for "a minute or two" she called to the victim's sister to see if everything was okay in the bathroom. The sister replied that it was. The victim's mother stated that the sister replied from the bedroom and not the bathroom.

The mother entered the bedroom and saw the sister at the foot of her, the sister's, bed. She scolded the sister for leaving the victim unattended. She ran into the bathroom and found the victim laying face down in the bathtub. She was out of the bathtub seat.

POST EVENT

The victim's mother picked the victim up and carried her into the dining area of the residence. Emergency personnel were summoned; CPR was attempted by the family friend and a neighbor until they arrived. The victim was transported to a local hospital; she was not revived.

NOTE

When the family friend was interviewed by the police department he told a story somewhat different than that told by the victim's mother. He said that while he was talking on the telephone the mother came out of the bathroom and said that she wanted to talk to his wife. He gave the telephone to the mother. He estimated that they talked for 5-10 minutes; "probably closer to ten minutes." During the conversation the sister came out of the bathroom wrapped in a towel. The mother scolded her and told her to go back into the bathroom and watch her sister. The friend and the mother thought she had done that. After the mother finished her conversation she went into the bathroom to check on the girls. She found the victim in the water(A).

PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION

The bathtub seat was labeled "MADE IN USA 1989 SAFETY 1 ST. INC. ALL RIGHTS RESERVED." It bore a warning in english to never leaved a child unattended. See attached photographs.

The seat is designed to be attached to a tub with four suction cups. The suction cups are removable from the seat. One of the suction cups was missing from the seat which was in evidence at the police department. The photograph taken by the police department at the scene of the event (Photo #6) shows that two of the suction cups were not attached to the seat after the event.

DETAILS:

On the date and time indicated on the face sheet of this report, the death of Taylor Dianne Jensen was reported to this office. Reportedly this subject was left unattended sitting in a plastic ring type bathtub seat at home with her four year old sister in the bathroom tub, and sometime later when the mother checked on the subject she found the infant out of the bathtub seat, lying face down in the water and the sister was out of the bathroom and in the bedroom. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation was initiated by a friend doing construction work at the residence and continued by a neighbor until paramedics arrived on the scene. The infant was then transported to the hospital by paramedics with continued cardiopulmonary resuscitation and I.V.'s and admitted to the emergency room at approximately 1430 hours; where cardiopulmonary resuscitation was taken over by Dr. Miller and the emergency room staff. Upon examining the infant Dr. Miller noted a 101 degree Fahrenheit temperature and what appeared to be trauma to the infant's rectum and vaginal areas. Dr. Miller further states that the infant appeared to be dry at the time of admit, including her hair, and that he could not find any anatomical signs of drowning, but that the infant did have what appeared to be water in the abdomen and water did come out during first aid procedures.

Medical history; reportedly no problems with delivery or pregnancy, but has received shots and the only known trauma was a cut hand that received sutures. Recently the mother states that the infant would pull back when she would wash her crotch area, but was unaware of any internal trauma or abuse.

This subject was then removed from the place of death by the Riverside County Coroner's Transportation Service and transported to the Riverside County Coroner's Facility pending further investigation of the death.

An autopsy was later conducted by Dr. DiTraglia and he was assisted by the child abuse expert physician from Riverside General Hospital who found what appeared to be some inflammation of the vaginal area but stated that there was no evidence of trauma or molestation and that the condition appeared to be from natural causes. The autopsy then established the cause of death appearing on the death certificate and on the face sheet of this report. For further medical evaluation refer to the autopsy protocol.

For further incident information refer to the Hemet Police Department investigation report.

This completed the coroner's investigation and the death was certified as being the result of a miscellaneous violent accident and the decedent's remains were released to the next of kin for final disposition.

SUMMARY OF CASE:

Reportedly this subject was left unattended sitting in a plastic ringed type bath tub seat at home with her 4 year old sister in the bathroom tub, and some time later when the mother checked on her she found the infant out of the bath tub seat, laying face down in the water and the sister was out of the bathroom in the bedroom. CPR was initiated by a friend doing construction work on the residence and continued by a neighbor till paramedics arrived on the scene. The infant was then transported to the hospital by paramedics with continued CPR and IV's and admitted to the ER at 1430 hours; where CPR was taken over by Dr Miller and ER staff. Upon examining the infant Dr Miller noted a 101°F temperature and what appeared to be trauma to the infants rectum and vagina. Dr Miller further states that the infant appeared to be dry at the time of admitt, including the hair, and that he could find no anatomical signs of drowning, but that the infant did have what appeared to be water in the abdomen and water did come out during first aid procedures.

This incident is under investigation by the Hemet Police Department.

Medical History: No problems with delivery or pregnancy. Has received shots and only trauma was a cut hand that received stiches. Recently mother states that the infant would pull back when she would wash crotch area, but was unaware of internal trauma.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

The body is that of an unembalmed, refrigerated Caucasian female infant who appears approximately the stated age of 9.5 months. The body is identified by toe tags. Prior to autopsy the body is weighed at 23 pounds. The body appears well developed and well nourished. Rigor mortis is well established. Livor mortis is visible over the dorsal thorax and bilateral upper extremities.

The head is normocephalic and the hair is blonde. Examination of the eyes reveals equal pupils, blue irides and white sclera. There are no conjunctival petechial hemorrhages. The oronasal passages are unobstructed. There are no traumatic injuries of the gingiva or oral mucosa. The frenulum is intact. Drying of the lips and the tip of the tongue is present. Upper and lower natural teeth are unerupted. The neck is unremarkable. The anterior/posterior diameter of the chest is within normal limits. There are no surgical scars present on the chest or abdomen. The anterior abdominal wall is unremarkable.

Edema of the extremities is not present. Joint deformities are not present. No needle tracks are identified. The hands are atraumatic.

The external genitalia are those of a prepubescent female. Obvious, circumferential vascular congestion is present around the vaginal introitus. However, incision reveals no evidence of contusion. No lacerations are identified. The hymen is intact. Examination of the anus reveals similar vascular congestion. In addition, multiple circumferential abrasions/excoriations are present covering an area measuring 3.0 cm in diameter. The squamocolumnar junction is irregular, but intact. Overall, the anal orifice has a stellate appearance. What appears to be healed scars (fissures) are present at 5 o'clock and 12 o'clock, each measuring 0.4 cm in length (assuming 12 o'clock to be superior). No lacerations are identified.

No external traumatic injuries are identified. On the right occipital scalp there is an area where the hair is absent measuring 1.6 cm in diameter.

EVIDENCE OF MEDICAL INTERVENTION

1. Nasogastric tube, left nostril
2. Endotracheal tube, mouth
3. Intravenous line, left jugular
4. Venipunctures, recent, inguinal, bilateral

CLOTHING

The body is unclothed.

INITIAL INCISION

The body cavities are entered through a standard Y-shaped incision. The musculature of the anterior chest is unremarkable. Each of the pleural cavities and the pericardial sac contains serous fluid.

Rib fractures are not identified. The lungs are well expanded. The organs of the thoracic and abdominal cavities have a normal arrangement. There is no blood present in the peritoneal cavity.

SYSTEMIC AND ORGAN REVIEW**CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM**

The aorta is elastic, of even caliber and exhibits a normal branching pattern. There is no significant atherosclerosis of the abdominal and thoracic aorta. The heart weighs 44 grams. The great vessels and the chambers have a normal configuration. The coronary ostia are widely patent. There are no septal defects. The valves are thin, leafy and without vegetation. All valvular circumferences are within normal limits. Serial sectioning of the myocardium reveals no abnormalities.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

No foreign material is present in the tracheobronchial tree. The tracheal mucosa is unremarkable. The right lung weighs 114 grams and the left lung weighs 96 grams. The lungs are focally subcrepitant and there is bilateral dependent congestion present. The visceral pleura are smooth and transparent. Serial sectioning of the parenchyma reveals no nodularity or consolidation. The pulmonary vasculature is without thromboembolism.

GASTROINTESTINAL SYSTEM

The esophagus and the stomach are intact. The gastric mucosa is unremarkable. No residual medication or capsular material is identified. The small intestine and colon are unremarkable. The appendix is present. The pancreas is unremarkable.

HEPATOBIILIARY SYSTEM

The liver weighs 412 grams. It is red-brown and the capsule is intact. The consistency is within normal limits. The cut surface is smooth. Acute passive congestion is present.

The gallbladder is unremarkable.

URINARY SYSTEM

The right kidney weighs 40 grams and the left kidney weighs 39.5 grams. The kidneys are normally situated and the capsules strip easily. The subcapsular surfaces are smooth. The corticomedullary demarcation is obscured by congestion. The ureters are not dilated. The urinary bladder is unremarkable.

GENITAL SYSTEM (FEMALE)

The uterus is symmetrical and the uterine cavity is not enlarged. The ovaries and fallopian tubes are unremarkable.

HEMOLYMPHATIC SYSTEM

The spleen weighs 36 grams. The capsule is intact. The parenchyma is dark red. The follicles are not prominent.

Lymph nodes throughout the body are unremarkable. The bone marrow has the usual appearance for the age.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM

The thyroid, adrenal glands and the pituitary gland are unremarkable. The thymus has the usual appearance for the age and weighs 31 grams.

CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM

There is no hemorrhage beneath the scalp, into the orbits, or into the temporalis muscles. There are no skull fractures and no intracranial hematomas. Generalized edema and softening are present. The brain weighs 880 grams. The leptomeninges are thin and transparent. A normal convolutionary pattern is observed. Serial coronal sectioning reveals no abnormalities. The cerebral hemispheres are symmetrical. The ventricular system is not dilated.

The pons, medulla and cerebellum are unremarkable. Uncal and/or cerebellar herniation is not prominent. The cerebral arteries show no significant atherosclerosis. The superior cervical spinal cord as viewed through the foramen magnum is unremarkable. The remainder of the spinal cord is not dissected.

NECK DISSECTION

The neck organs are removed en bloc from the anterior approach. There is no hemorrhage within the anterior strap or sternocleidomastoid muscles. The hyoid bone and the larynx are intact. The larynx is opened posteriorly. The vocal cords are unremarkable. There is no prevertebral muscle or fascial hemorrhage.

HISTOLOGIC SECTIONS

Representative sections are stored in formalin.

Sections are submitted for histologic processing.

TOXICOLOGY

Blood is collected.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs are taken prior to the autopsy.

RADIOLOGY

X-rays are taken prior to the autopsy.





ASSIGNMENT:

ON MARCH 07, 1991 AT APPROX. 15:40 HRS. I WAS TOLD BY SUPERVISION TO GO TO THE HEMET VALLEY HOSPITAL EMERGENCY ROOM AND INITIATE AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE DROWNING DEATH AND POSSIBLE SEXUAL MOLESTATION ON A 9 MONTH OLD FEMALE. I RESPONDED AND ARRIVED AT 15:45 HRS. ALSO ASSISTING ME IN THIS INVESTIGATION WAS DET. KEVIN CASKEY OF THE HEMET POLICE DEPT.

INITIAL OBSERVATIONS:

ON ARRIVAL I WENT INTO THE TRAUMA ROOM WHERE I SAW SEVERAL OF THE HOSPITAL STAFF MEMBERS AROUND THE BODY OF AN INFANT FEMALE. ALL OF WHOM I SAW WERE VERY UPSET AND WERE OR HAD BEEN CRYING OVER THE INCIDENT.

I TOLD ONE OF THE NURSES I WAS THERE TO INVESTIGATE THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DEATH OF THE INFANT AND THAT I WAS TOLD THERE WAS A REPORT THE CHILD MAY HAVE BEEN MOLESTED. DR. LON MILLER, THE ATTENDING PHYSICIAN, WAS PRESENT AND INDICATED HE HAD SEEN EXTENSIVE TRAUMA TO THE RECTAL AND POSSIBLY THE VAGINAL AREAS OF THE INFANT, A FINDING WHICH WAS THEN REFERED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

I THEN EXAMINED THE INFANT, IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] AND NOTED THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.) [REDACTED] APPEARED TO BE A WELL NURISHED, CLEAN, AND WELL DEVELOPED INFANT GIRL OF NINE MONTHS OF AGE.
- 2.) [REDACTED] SKIN AND HAIR WAS DRY TO APPEARANCE AND TOUCH. [REDACTED] HAIR, I NOTICED TO BE OF FINE TEXTURE AND STANDING UP, NOT WET, MATTED OR STUCK TO HER HEAD.
- 3.) [REDACTED] SKIN SURFACE APPEARED TO BE SMOOTH WITH NO NOTICABLE BRUISING, CUTS. THERE WERE TWO TINY SCRATCHES LOCATED ON [REDACTED] FOREHEAD. IT IS NOT KNOWN HOW OR WHEN THESE SCRATCHES OCCURED.
- 4.) [REDACTED] WAS CYANOTIC (BLUE) THROUGH-OUT HER FACE AND HANDS. THE REMAINDER OF HER SKIN APPEARED TO HAVE MOTTLED COLORING AND WAS COOL TO THE TOUCH.
- 5.) I NOTED THE FLESHY AREA OF [REDACTED]S PUBIC REGION TO BE RED AND SOMEWHAT SWOLLEN.
- 6.) CLOSER EXAMINATION REVEALED THE VAGINAL AREA APPEARED TO RED, SWOLLEN, AND BRUISED. DR. MILLER AND ATTENDING NURSES AGREED WITH THIS.
- 7.) THE TISSUES AND SURROUNDING SKIN IN THE AREA OF THE VAGINAL OPENING APPEARED TO BE IRRITATED AND DISCOLORED.

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- B.) THE TISSUES SURROUNDING THE RECTAL OPENING APPEARED TO BE TORN AND EVEN DISLODGED IN SOME AREAS. DISCOLORATION WAS ALSO VISIBLE AROUND THE RECTUM. IN THE MIST OF THE DISCOLORATION IN THE AREA OF THE RECTUM WERE TINY ABRASIONS. I WAS TOLD THESE ARE COMMONLY CAUSED BY SOME FRICTION OVER THE AREA.
- 9.) I NOTED A SMALL AMOUNT OF DRIED BLOOD ALONG THE EDGES OF [REDACTED] UPPER AND LOWER LIPS AND A SLIGHT AMOUNT OF BLOOD ON HER GUMS.

BASED ON MY TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE THE SIGNS FOUND ON TAYLOR WERE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE FOUND ON A SEXUALLY ABUSED CHILD. SPECIFICLY THOSE CHILDREN WHO HAVE BEEN SODOMIZED. DR. MILLER AND NURSES PRESENT AGREED [REDACTED] APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN A VICTIM OF A SEXUAL MOLESTATION. I WAS FURTHER ADVISED THERE WAS SOME DISCREPENCY AS TO WHERE AND EVEN IF [REDACTED] HAD ACTUALLY DROWN.

AFTER BEING BRIEFED ABOUT THE UNCERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING [REDACTED] DEATH AND AFTER SEEING WHAT APPEARED TO BE MOLESTATION TYPE TRAUMA TO [REDACTED], I DETERMINED THERE WAS SUFFICIENT GROUNDS TO CONDUCT A CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION.

I THEN INSTRUCTED DETECTIVE CASKEY TO CONTACT FAMILY MEMBERS WHO WERE PRESENT AT THE HOSPITAL. I ALSO INSTRUCTED OFFICER GARDNER TO RESPOND TO THE VICTIM'S HOME AND SECURE THE SCENE FOR A POSSIBLE SEARCH WARRANT LATER. I THEN TOOK STATEMENTS FROM THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYEES WHO WERE INVOLVED IN THE RESUSCITATIVE EFFORTS OF TAYLOR.

STATEMENT OF McADAMS:

McADAMS SAID SHE WORKS AS A TRAUMA ROOM NURSE FOR THE HEMET VALLEY HOSPITAL AND IS ALSO TRAINED AS A MOBILE INTENSIVE CARE NURSE TO WORK WITH PARAMEDICS. McADAMS SAID IN HER CAREER SHE HAS WORKED ON THREE DROWNINGS, 1 CHILD, 1 INFANT, AND [REDACTED]. McADAMS HAS ALSO SEEN SEVERAL CHILD ABUSE VICTIMS, ONE OF WHICH WAS SEXUALLY ABUSED. McADAMS SAID [REDACTED] APPEARED TO BE FAR WORSE THAN WHAT SHE HAD SEEN BEFORE.

McADAMS SAID AT 14:13 HRS. THE HOSPITAL'S PARAMEDIC CALL ALARM WAS ANSWERED BY MOBILE INTENSIVE CARE NURSE, JANET WHITE. McADAMS WALKED PAST THE RADIO ROOM WHERE WHITE WAS TALKING WITH PARAMEDICS ABOUT 1 TO 2 MINUTES AFTER THE CALL CAME IN. McADAMS SAID WHITE SAID THE CALL WAS OF A DROWN INFANT AND ASKED FOR ASSISTANCE ON THE CALL.

McADAMS SAID SOMEONE HAD TOLD WHITE THE BABY HAD DROWN IN A JACUZZI. McADAMS ASKED IF THE WATER IN THE JACUZZI WAS HOT OR COLD. THE PARAMEDIC ON THE RADIO REPLIED THE WATER WAS COLD BECAUSE THE JACUZZI HAD BEEN TURNED OFF ABOUT A WEEK. McADAMS SAID SHE BRIEFLY HELPED ON THE CALL THEN WENT TO THE TRAUMA ROOM

TO SET UP FOR THE ARRIVAL OF THE DROWN INFANT.

McADAMS SAID THE PERSONELL WHO WERE IN CHARGE AT THE HOSPITAL WERE DR. LON MILLER, McADAMS, AND JANET WHITE. OTHERS INVOLVED WERE THE ON DUTY STAFF OF THE CARDIOLOGY AND RESPIRATORY DEPT.S

McADAMS SAID AFTER THE ARRIVAL OF [REDACTED] AND AT SOME POINT DURING THE EFFORTS ON TAYLOR, JANET WHITE OBTAINED A RECTAL TEMPERATURE ON [REDACTED] OF 101.2 DEGREES. JUST PRIOR TO THE INSERTION OF THE RECTAL THEMOMETER JANET WHITE SAID, "OH OH. I THINK WE HAVE A PROBLEM HERE." WHITE THEN HAD DR. MILLER LOOK AT WHAT APPEARED TO BE SEVERELY TRAUMATIZED RECTUM. AFTER DR. MILLER EXAMINED [REDACTED] RECTUM HE HAD SOMEONE CALL THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEN ASKED IF SHE NOTED ANYTHING UNUSUAL ABOUT [REDACTED] OVERALL APPEARANCE McADAMS SAID SHE HAD. McADAMS SAID SHE THOUGHT IT ODD THAT A DROWN BABY WOULD LOOK AND FEEL SO DRY AND THAT HER HAIR WOULD BE STICKING-OUT INSTEAD OF MATTED DOWN TO HER HEAD. McADAMS SAID IN HER EXPERIENCE WITH PAST DROWNING VICTIMS SHE HAS KNOWN THEM TO BE AT LEAST DAMP AND AGREED THEY HAVE HAD WEF OR MATTED HAIR.

McADAMS FURTHER STATED THAT, ASIDE FROM THE WHAT APPEARED TO BE A MOLESTATION TYPE TRAUMA TO [REDACTED] THE BABY APPEARED TO BE HEALTHY AND WELL DEVELOPED. McADAMS ADDED THAT FROM HER EXPERIENCE IN RAISING CHILDREN THE INJURIES TO [REDACTED] WERE OBVIOUS ENOUGH AND TO A DEGREE THAT THE MOTHER HAD TO KNOW SOMETHING WAS WRONG.

WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE BLOOD I HAD SEEN AROUND [REDACTED] LIPS McADAMS SAID SHE HAD NOT NOTICED IT. McADAMS THEN SAID IT COULD HAVE HAPPENED DURING THE INTUBATION PROCESS AS THE AIRWAY WAS ESTABLISHED.

McADAMS SAID AT ONE POINT DURING THE RESUSCITATIVE EFFORTS SHE CONTACTED THE MOTHER IN REGARD TO THE TEMPERATURE OF THE WATER IN THE "JACUZZI". IT WAS AT THIS POINT THAT McADAMS WAS TOLD THE BABY DROWN IN THE BATHTUB. McADAMS SAID THE MOTHER, [REDACTED] SAID SHE WAS BATHING THE BABY IN THE BATHTUB AND HAD THE WATER HOT, "POSSIBLY TOO HOT" ACCORDING TO THE MOTHER.

McADAMS SAID AFTER RESUSCITATIVE EFFORTS WERE STOPPED AND THE PARENTS WERE TOLD, THE PARENTS LEFT IMMEDIATELY. AS THEY WERE LEAVING McADAMS HEARD THE MOTHER, MEADS, SAY TO THE FATHER, [REDACTED] THAT SHE WAS THE ONE CARING [REDACTED] AND THAT HE COULD NOT BLAME HIMSELF FOR WHAT HAD HAPPENED.

McADAMS SAID IF NEEDED AT A LATER DATE THE PARAMEDIC RUN TAPE WAS TAPE NUMBER 3, RUN 3-132 AND WAS CALLED IN AT 14:13 HRS. McADAMS COULD PROVIDE NOTHING FURTHER. I NEXT SPOKE WITH DR. LON MILLER, THE DOCTOR WHO HAD TRIED TO REVIV [REDACTED] AND HAD PRONOUNCED HER DEAD.

STATEMENT OF DR. LON MILLER:

IN REGARD TO EXPERIENCE WITH DROWNING VICTIMS DR. MILLER INDICATED TO ME HE HAS HAD TRAINING IN THE MATTER AND HAS PERSONALLY PERFORMED RESUSCITATIVE EFFORTS ON SIX DROWNING VICTIMS IN HIS CAREER.

DR. MILLER SAID HE WAS ON DUTY IN THE HEMET HOSPITAL EMERGENCY ROOM WHEN A PARAMEDIC CALL OF AN INFANT DROWNING IN A POOL CAME IN OVER THE RADIO. DR. MILLER SAID TO HIS KNOWLEDGE THE PARAMEDICS DID WHAT THEY COULD FOR THE INFANT IN THE FIELD AND THEN TRANSPORTED THE INFANT TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM.

DR. MILLER SAID PARAMEDICS CANNOT INTUBATE INFANTS IN THE FIELD SO IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL OF THE INFANT DR. MILLER INTUBATED THE INFANT, ESTABLISHING THE AIRWAY AND LIFELINES.

DR. MILLER SAID AS HE INSERTED THE ENDOTRACHEAL AIRWAY AND WORKED ON THE INFANT [REDACTED] HE NOTED SEVERAL THINGS ABOUT [REDACTED] THAT HE THOUGHT TO BE INCONSISTENT WITH THE TYPICAL DROWNING VICTIM HE HAS BEEN FAMILIAR WITH IN HIS TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE.

DR. MILLER SAID HE NOTED THERE WAS NO PRESENCE OF WATER IN THE PHARYNX OR IN THE TRACHEAL REGION AS HE HAS SEEN IN THE PAST. DR. MILLER SAID WATER IS USUALLY PRESENT IN SOME AMOUNT IN THESE AREAS THOUGH THE AMOUNT MAY BE VERY SMALL.

FURTHER THE INFANT DID NOT HAVE ANY SIGN OF WRINKLING OF HER FINGERS AND TOES AS IS PRESENT IN WATER IMMERSION TYPE OF INCIDENTS. DR. MILLER ALSO SAID THE INFANT'S SKIN WAS DRY AS WAS HER HAIR WHICH HE THOUGHT WAS UNUSUAL. I ASKED IF IN DR. MILLER'S OPINION THE INFANT LOOKED LIKE A DROWNING VICTIM. DR. MILLER SAID IT WAS POSSIBLE, HOWEVER BY OUTWARD APPEARANCES A DROWNING WAS CERTAINLY QUESTIONABLE.

DR. MILLER FURTHER CHECKED FOR ANY SIGNS OF PITICIAL HEMORRAGE IN THE AREA OF THE INFANT'S EYES. THE HEMORRAGE IS A RESULT OF THE PRESSURE BUILD UP IN THE HEAD OF A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN STRANGLER. TO SIGN OF PITICIAL HEMORRAGE WAS FOUND.

OTHER OBSERVATIONS DR. MILLER MADE OF [REDACTED] WERE OF WHAT MIGHT BE MORE EXPECTED IN AN APNEIC/ASYSTOLE PATIENT. SPECIFICLY THESE WOULD BE DILATED AND NONRESPONSIVE PUPILS, COOL SKIN, ASHEN COLORING WITH MOTTLING IN THE EXTREMITIES, AND LACK OF OVERALL VITAL SIGNS OF LIFE.

DR. MILLER SAID A NASAL-GASTRIC TUBE WAS INSERTED TO DRAIN OFF THE WATER THAT WAS IN THE STOMACH. DR. MILLER ESTIMATED THERE WAS 30-40 cc'S OF WATER TAKEN OUT [REDACTED] AMOUNT THAT WOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED UNCOMMON.

WHEN ASKED IF ANY TRAUMA TO THE MOUTH AREA WAS DETECTED, DR. MILLER SAID HE SAW NONE. DR. MILLER SAID THE SMALL AMOUNT OF BLOOD ON THE INFANT'S LIPS COULD EASILY HAVE BEEN CAUSED DURING THE INTUBATION PROCESS. DR. MILLER COULD PROVIDE NO FURTHER INFORMATION.

I NEXT SPOKE WITH DEBORAH MORGAN, A REGISTERED NURSE WHO WORKS IN THE EMERGENCY ROOM AND ASSISTED IN THE EFFORTS [REDACTED]

STATEMENT OF MORGAN:

MORGAN SAID SHE CAME ON DUTY AT 15:00 HRS. AND THE INFANT WAS ALREADY HERE WITH EFFORTS TO REVIVE THE INFANT IN PROCESS. MORGAN SAID AFTER THE EFFORTS CEASED SHE STOOD BY IN THE TRAUMA ROOM WHILE THE INFANT'S FATHER CAME IN AND HELD THE BABY. WITH THE FATHER WAS A YOUNG GIRL WHO SAID SHE WAS ASHLEY, THE INFANT'S SISTER. BOTH ASHLEY AND THE FATHER TOOK TURNS HOLDING THE BABY.

MORGAN SAID ASHLEY SEEMED VERY UPSET AT THE LOSS OF HER SISTER. MORGAN SAID THE FATHER EXPLAINED ASHLEY LIVES IN HEMET WITH HER GRANDMOTHER AND WOULD BABYSIT OFTEN. THE TWO HAD BEEN VERY CLOSE.

WITH MY PERMISSION MORGAN TOOK AN INK PAD AND PRINTED [REDACTED] FEET ON A PIECE OF PAPER FOR ASHLEY TO HAVE SOMETHING TO REMEMBER TAYLOR BY. AFTER THIS I HAD THE FAMILY LEAVE THE ROOM AND THEN COVERED [REDACTED] HANDS AND FEET WITH PLASTIC BAGS TO PRESERVE ANY POSSIBLE TYPE OF EVIDENCE UNDER THE NAILBEDS.

MORGAN BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION A DISCHARGE SHE HAD NOTICED COMING FROM [REDACTED] VAGINAL AREA. I HAD MORGAN TAKE SWABS AND SMEARS OF THIS FOR ANALYSIS LATER. MORGAN SAID THE FLUID APPEARED TO BE CLEAR AND COULD BE WATER. I TOOK THE ITEMS AS EVIDENCE.

MORGAN NEXT ASSISTED DR. REEVES WITH A WOODS LAMP AND SCANNED [REDACTED] GROIN AREA WITH IT. THE WOODS LAMP WILL SHOW THE PRESENCE OF SEMINAL FLUIDS ON SKIN TISSUE. NONE WAS DETECTED.

WHEN ASKED HOW MANY PRIOR DROWNINGS MORGAN HAS HAD EXPERIENCE WITH MORGAN SAID SHE HAS WORKED ON FOUR DROWNINGS TOTAL, THREE OF THESE WERE ON INFANTS. WHEN ASKED IF THERE WAS ANYTHING SHE THOUGHT UNUSUAL ABOUT THIS DROWNING MORGAN SAID SHE THOUGHT IT STRANGE THAT THERE WAS NO SKIN WRINKLING AND THE BABY APPEARED AS THOUGH SHE HAD NOT BEEN IN THE WATER.

MORGAN COULD PROVIDE NO OTHER INFORMATION AT THIS TIME. I NEXT INTERVIEWED ASHLEY PENNELL, THE 10 YEAR OLD SISTER OF THE DECEASED INFANT. DURING THE INTERVIEWS WITH THESE ABOVE SUBJECTS DET. CASKEY CONDUCTED INTERVIEWS WITH OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS AT THE HOSPITAL.

I EXPLAINED TO [REDACTED] WHO I WAS AND THAT I HAD SOME QUESTIONS TO ASK HER ABOUT HERSELF AND HER SISTER [REDACTED]. I DID NOT TELL ASHLEY ABOUT THE MOLESTATION AT THIS POINT.

[REDACTED] TOLD ME SHE WAS 10 YEARS OLD AND LIVES WITH HER GRANDMOTHER IN A MOBILE HOME PARK ON STATE STREET IN HEMET. [REDACTED] SAID SHE HAS LIVED WITH HER GRANDMOTHER ALL OF HER LIFE BECAUSE OF PROBLEMS WITH HER REAL MOTHER AND HER REAL FATHER.

[REDACTED] SAID WHEN SHE WAS JUST A LITTLE BABY HER MOTHER AND HER FATHER FOUGHT OFTEN AND HER MOTHER WOULD BE BEATEN BY HER FATHER. THEY COULD NOT AFFORD TO RAISE HER AND FELT SHE WOULD BE BETTER STAYING WITH HER GRANDMOTHER FOR A WHILE, AT LEAST UNTIL THINGS GOT BETTER FOR THEM. ASHLEY SAID THINGS NEVER GOT BETTER AND SHE JUST STAYED WITH HER GRANDMOTHER ALL OF HER LIFE.

[REDACTED] SAID THIS ALL TOOK PLACE IN NORTH CAROLINA. AFTER SOME TIME HER MOTHER AND HER FATHER SEPERATED AND THEY MOVED TO CALIFORNIA. [REDACTED] FATHER STAYED IN NORTH CAROLINA AND SHE CONTINUED TO LIVE WITH HER GRANDMOTHER.

I THEN ASKED [REDACTED] TO TELL ME ABOUT [REDACTED] AND HOW SHE FELT ABOUT HER [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] SAID SHE LOVED [REDACTED] VERY MUCH AND THE TWO OF THEM WERE VERY CLOSE. [REDACTED] SAID SHE BABYSAT [REDACTED] OFTEN AND ENJOYED DOING SO. [REDACTED] SAID SHE ALSO HELPED TO CHANGE [REDACTED] DIAPERS FROM TIME TO TIME WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF HER GRANDMOTHER OR HER MOTHER. THE LAST TIME WAS ABOUT A WEEK AGO.

WHEN ASKED IF SHE EVER NOTICED ANYTHING UNUSUAL LIKE BLOOD OR STRANGE SPOTS IN [REDACTED] DIAPERS OR IF [REDACTED] EVER ACTED LIKE THE AREA OF HER PRIVATE PARTS HURT HER, [REDACTED] SAID SHE HAD NEVER NOTICED ANYTHING LIKE THAT BEFORE. WHEN ASKED IF SHE HAD EVER SEEN ANYONE TOUCHING [REDACTED] IN A WAY THEY PROBABLY SHOULD NOT [REDACTED] SAID SHE HAD NOT SEEN THIS.

I THEN ASKED [REDACTED] IF ANYONE HAD EVER TREATED HER IN A BAD WAY OR HAD TOUCHED HER IN HER PRIVATE AREAS IN A WAY THEY SHOULD NOT. [REDACTED] SAID NO ONE HAD. WHEN ASKED IF SHE KNEW WHAT I WAS REFERING TO [REDACTED] SAID YES AND POINTED TO HER GROIN AREA. [REDACTED] SAID SHE HAD LEARNED ABOUT IT IN SCHOOL AND FROM HER GRANDMOTHER.

WHEN ASKED HOW SHE FELT ABOUT HER MOTHER [REDACTED] SAID SHE LOVES HER MOTHER, SHE JUST PREFERS TO BE LIVING WITH HER GRANDMOTHER BECAUSE THAT WAS ALL SHE HAD KNOWN. WHEN ASKED HOW [REDACTED] FELT ABOUT HER STEP-FATHER [REDACTED] SAID SHE LIKED HIM AND GOT ALONG WELL WITH DANA.

I NOTED THROUGH-OUT MY INTERVIEW [REDACTED] REFERED TO HER MOTHER AS [REDACTED] AND NOT BY THE MORE COMMON TERMS. I ALSO NOTED AS [REDACTED] TO SEEM MORE MATURE THAN HER ACTUAL AGE [REDACTED] SEEMED TO KNOW MORE

ABOUT LIFE AND RESPONSIBILITY IN GENERAL THAN OTHER GIRLS HER AGE I HAVE TALKED WITH.

AFTER TALKING WITH [REDACTED] SPOKE WITH RANDY CLEMENS, EMT 1-A AND SCOTT TOLSON, CERTIFIED PARAMEDIC. BOTH ARE EMPLOYEES OF THE HEMET VALLEY AMBULANCE SERVICE AND RESPONDED TO THE SCENE OF THE DROWNING. I SPOKE TO BOTH OF THE SUBJECTS ALONE BUT BECAUSE THEIR STATEMENTS WERE SO SIMILAR I WILL INCLUDE BOTH STATEMENTS UNDER ONE HEADING. TOLSON HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN FIVE PRIOR INFANT DROWNING, CLEMENS HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN TWO.

STATEMENT OF TOLSON AND CLEMENS:

BOTH SAID THE PARAMEDIC UNIT WAS THE LAST TO ARRIVE AT THE SCENE, AT APPROX. 14:08 HRS. THEY HAD BEEN ADVISED OF THE CONFIRMED DROWNING SLIGHTLY AHEAD OF TIME AND WERE PREPARED FOR IT ON ARRIVAL. BOTH SAID ONCE ON SCENE FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL WERE AT THE HOUSE. THE FIREMEN WERE INSIDE AND A POLICEMAN WAS STANDING OUTSIDE. ALSO OUTSIDE IN THE FRONT YARD WAS AN HYSTRICAL WOMAN THEY LATER DETERMINED TO BE THE MOTHER OF THE VICTIM. =

INSIDE THE HOUSE THEY WERE DIRECTED BY PERSONNEL TO THE REAR OF THE HOUSE IN THE DEN AREA. THERE THEY SAW THE INFANT FACE UP ON THE FLOOR OF THE DEN WITH CPR IN PROGRESS. BOTH AGREED THE BABY WAS NUDE, WET, AND COOL TO TOUCH. THE SKIN WAS PALE OR ASHEN AND THE BABY'S EYES WERE NONRESPONSIVE TO LIGHT.

BOTH AGREED THE BABY APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN IN THE WATER RECENTLY AND SAID AS CPR PROGRESSED A GREAT DEAL OF WATER CAME OUT OF THE INFANT'S MOUTH. AT ONE POINT PRESSURE WAS APPLIED TO THE INFANT'S ABDOMINAL AREA TO FORCE OUT THE WATER INSIDE. TOLSON SAID A LOT OF WATER CAME UP.

TOLSON SAID AS THEY SET UP SOME OF THEIR EQUIPMENT HE NOTED ONE OF THE FIRE PERSONNEL TAKE A TOWEL AND DRY THE INFANT'S HEAD. TOLSON SAID HE HEARD SOMEONE SAY THE BABY HAD DROWN IN A JACCUZI. HE DID NOT KNOW WHO SAID IT BUT HE THOUGHT THAT WAS THE CASE AND RELAYED THE INFORMATION TO THE HOSPITAL. BOTH SAID THEY GLANCED OUT OF THE NEARBY PATIO WINDOW AND NOTICED AN AREA OF CONSTRUCTION IN THE REAR YARD BUT DID NOT SEE A POOL.

BOTH ASKED THE PERSONELL ON SCENE AND OTHERS WHO WERE THERE (MOTHER AND A FEMALE NEIGHBOR [REDACTED]) HOW LONG THE BABY HAD BEEN DOWN BEFORE SHE WAS FOUND. NO ONE KNEW FOR SURE AND COULD ONLY ESTIMATE. BOTH AGREED THE BABY APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN DOWN AND LIFELESS FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD. WHEN ASKED BY THE HOSPITAL IF THE JACCUZI WATER WAS HOT OR COLD SOME ONE SAID THE JACCUZI WAS TURNED OFF. TOLSON REPORTED THE WATER WAS COLD.

AFTER INITIAL EFFORTS TO REVIVE THE BABY FAILED SHE WAS THEN TRANSPORTED BY AMBULANCE TO THE HOSPITAL AT 14:20 HRS. AS THE UNIT WAS LEAVING A DARK COLORED TRUCK ARRIVED WITH TWO MEN IN IT.

ONE OF THE MEN GOT OUT AND THE OTHER FOLLOWED THE AMBULANCE TO THE HOSPITAL. CLEMENS SAID THE MAN DRIVING THE TRUCK FOLLOWED CLOSELY BEHIND AND WENT THROUGH LIGHTS AND STOP SIGNS WITH THEM. THE MAN LATER IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS DANA THE INFANT'S FATHER.

THE AMBULANCE THEN ARRIVED AT THE HEMET HOSPITAL WITHOUT MISHAP AND WITHOUT POSITIVE RESULTS FROM THE VICTIM AT 14:26 HRS. EFFORTS TO REVIVE THE BABY WERE CONTINUED BY DR. MILLER AND HIS STAFF.

AFTER COMPLETING MY INTERVIEWS WITH THE ABOVE SUBJECTS I NEXT CONTACTED JIM CAMP WHO HAD ARRIVED AT THE HOSPITAL FROM THE CORONERS OFFICE AT APPROX. 17:50 HRS. DET. CASKEY AND MR. CAMP TOOK SEVERAL PHOTOS OF TAYLOR'S BODY IN ADDITION TO SOME PHOTOS I HAD TAKEN ON MY ARRIVAL AT THE HOSPITAL. [REDACTED] BODY WAS THEN TURNED OVER TO THE CORONER'S OFFICE FOR TRANSPORTATION TO RIVERSIDE. REFER TO RIVERSIDE COUNTY CORONER'S CASE #71994.

MR. CAMP THEN ACCOMPANIED DET. CASKEY AND I TO THE VICTIM'S HOME FOR INTERVIEWS WITH THE PARENTS. BOTH PARENTS HAD LEFT THE HOSPITAL PRIOR TO MY INITIAL ARRIVAL. TO SECURE THE SCENE OF THE HOUSE I HAD OFFICER DON GARDENER GO TO THE HOUSE AND REMAIN THERE UNTIL I WAS FINISHED AT THE HOSPITAL.

AT 18:48 HRS. WE ARRIVED AT THE VICTIMS'S HOME LOCATED AT [REDACTED] IN HEMET. AT THE RESIDENCE WHEN WE ARRIVED WAS OFFICER TAVAREZ OF THE HEMET POLICE DEPT. WHO HAD RELIEVED OFFICER GARDENER AT THE END OF HIS SHIFT. ALSO PRESENT WAS [REDACTED] MOTHER OF [REDACTED] FATHER OF [REDACTED] THE SISTER OF [REDACTED] AUNT, AND [REDACTED] A FRIEND OF THE FAMILY. ALL WERE PRESENT IN THE FRONT ROOM AT OUR ARRIVAL. I INTERVIEWED ALL OF THOSE PRESENT EXCEPT RICHUISA. DET. CASKEY TOOK CARE OF THIS.

PRIOR TO INTERVIEWING THE SUBJECTS I HAD ALL OF THEM GO INTO A NEARBY BEDROOM WITH OFFICER TAVAREZ. I TOLD TAVAREZ TO ALLOW THEM TO TALK BUT NOT ABOUT THE INCIDENT. I THEN TOOK JESSICA LOZON INTO THE FRONT ROOM AND STARTING AT 19:00 HRS I BEGAN MY INTERVIEW WITH LOZON.

STATEMENT OF LOZON:

LOZON SAID SHE WAS HOME WHEN THE INCIDENT OCCURED AND LIVES ONLY A SHORT DISTANTANCE AWAY. LOZON WAS CALLED BY HER MOTHER AND CAME RIGHT OVER. ON LOZON'S ARRIVAL THE AMBULANCE WAS ALREADY ON SCENE AND [REDACTED] WAS IN THE FRONT YARD CRYING.

LOZON SAID [REDACTED] THE BABY'S FATHER, WAS NOT HOME WHEN SHE ARRIVED BUT WAS AT WORK. [REDACTED] ARRIVED IN HIS TRUCK WITH BUDDY AS THE AMBULANCE WAS LEAVING. [REDACTED] FOLLOWED THE AMBULANCE TO THE HOSPITAL. BUDDY STAYED AT THE HOUSE.

LOZON SAID THOUGH SHE LIVES NEARBY SHE DOESN'T VISIT OFTEN BECAUSE SHE IS JUST INVOLVED IN HER OWN LIFE AND PROBLEMS.

WHEN TOLD ABOUT THE SUSPECTED MOLESTATION TO [REDACTED] [REDACTED] BECAME HORRIFIED AND WANTED TO KNOW IF WE KNEW WHO WAS RESPONSIBLE. [REDACTED] ALSO ASKED - IF WE WERE SURE THE INJURIES WERE CAUSED BY A MOLESTATION AND NOT SOME OTHER MEANS. I EXPLAINED THE MOLESTATION WAS STRONGLY SUSPECTED BUT NOT OFFICIALLY CONFIRMED.

[REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED]'S PROBLEM IS THAT SHE JUST DOESN'T THINK AND IS CARELESS.

[REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED] RELYS A GREAT DEAL ON BRITANY TO KEEP AN EYE ON [REDACTED] AND TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR [REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED] IS JUST BARELY FOUR YEARS OLD AND IS NOT CAPABLE OF SUCH RESPONSIBILITY. DURING MY INTERVIEW WITH [REDACTED] I NOTED HER TO BE SEVERELY EMOTIONALLY UPSET, CRYING, REFUSING TO BELIEVE, CLUTCHING AT THE FURNITURE CUSHIONS, AND BURYING HER FACE INTO HER HANDS.

I EXPLAINED THAT I WAS CONDUCTING AN INVESTIGATION AND NEEDED TO HAVE SOME QUESTIONS ANSWERED IN REGARD TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF [REDACTED] DEATH. I SAID THERE WERE SOME THINGS I DID NOT UNDERSTAND AND WOULD APPRECIATE [REDACTED] HELP IN UNDERSTANDING WHAT HAD HAPPENED.

[REDACTED] SAID SHE UNDERSTOOD AND WOULD COOPERATE. [REDACTED] BEGAN CRYING AND SAID IT WAS ALL HER FAULT. IN A SPONTANEOUS STATEMENT [REDACTED] SAID SHE SHOULD NEVER HAVE LEFT THE BABY IN THE TUB LIKE SHE DID. [REDACTED] SAID SHE WAS NOT THINKING AND KNEW IT WAS WRONG FOR HER TO DO. [REDACTED] SAID SHE ALWAYS BATHES THEM TOGETHER. DIANE SAID [REDACTED] IS FOUR YEARS OLD AND CAN TAKE CARE OF HERSELF IN THE TUB. [REDACTED] WAS JUST BEGINNING TO LEARN HOW TO STAND AND NEEDED TO BE WATCHED.

[REDACTED] SAID WHEN SHE BATHED THE GIRLS SHE HAS A BLUE PLASTIC BATH CHAIR THAT IS SUCTIONED CUPPED TO THE FLOOR OF THE TUB. TAYLOR THEN SAT INSIDE OF IT AND WAS NOT SUPPOSED TO BE ABLE TO GET OUT OF IT, (THIS CHAIR WAS PHOTOGRAPHED AND TAKEN AS EVIDENCE). DIANE SAID THIS CHAIR WAS USED IN TODAY'S BATH AS IN ALL OTHERS. I NOTED THE CHAIR WAS STILL WET FROM RECENT USE.

WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE JACUZZI DIANE SAID SHE HAD NO IDEA HOW THE HOSPITAL WAS TOLD TAYLOR HAD BEEN IN A JACUZZI. [REDACTED] SAID THEY HAVE ONE BUT IT WAS DRAINED TWO WEEKS AGO. [REDACTED] SAID, "I WAS GIVING [REDACTED] A BATH IN THE BATHTUB. I LEFT HER AND I SHOULD NOT HAVE DONE THAT. [REDACTED] DIED AND NOW I'LL HAVE TO LIVE WITH THAT THE REST OF MY LIFE." [REDACTED] SAID THEIR SEXUAL RELATIONSHIP IS TERRIBLE AND ALMOST NONEXISTENT. [REDACTED] SAID THE LAST TIME THEY MADE LOVE WAS ABOUT FOUR NIGHTS AGO AND IT WAS GOOD. JUST NOT OFTEN ENOUGH.

[REDACTED] SAID WHEN SHE AND [REDACTED] WERE FIRST TOGETHER, FOR ABOUT THE FIRST THREE MONTHS, THEIR SEX LIFE WAS GREAT. SINCE THEN, THEY ARE NOT TOGETHER OFTEN AND WHEN THEY ARE, THEY ARE TOO EXHAUSTED TO DO ANYTHING. [REDACTED] SAID WHEN [REDACTED] WAS BORN SHE HAD HER TUBES TIED SO AS NOT TO HAVE ANYMORE CHILDREN.

DIANE WAS LATER ABLE TO PROVIDE ██████████ ADDRESS OF 242 MAYFLOWER #B IN HEMET.

THE RAPE RESULTED IN A PREGNANCY THE RESULT OF WHICH WAS HER DAUGHTER, ██████████ SAID SHE MARRIED THE MAN WHO RAPED AND EVENTUALLY HAD ANOTHER DAUGHTER BY HIM.

I THEN ASKED IF THEIR RELATIONSHIP WAS SO GREAT THEN WHAT WAS IT THEY WERE ARGUING ABOUT ON THE PHONE TODAY JUST PRIOR TO [REDACTED] DEATH. [REDACTED] LOOKED SHOCKED AND SAID THERE WAS NO ARGUMENT. [REDACTED] SAID SHE HAD CALLED DIANE'S HOUSE AND TALKED WITH BOTH BUDDY AND [REDACTED] ON THE PHONE FOR SEVERAL MINUTES. [REDACTED] JUST SAID HE WAS COMING HOME AND WOULD PICK UP THE CHILDREN ON THE WAY. WHEN ASKED IF SHE WAS SURE SHE SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] ON THE PHONE [REDACTED] SAID SHE WAS CERTAIN AND HAD TALKED FOR AT LEAST FIVE MINUTES, PROBABLY LONGER.

WHEN ASKED ABOUT [REDACTED] PAST CHRISTINA SAID [REDACTED] CAME FROM A BROKEN HOME AND WAS THE BEST PRODUCT OF HIS FAMILY. [REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED] HAS HAD A DRUG PROBLEM IN THE PAST BUT THAT IS ALL BEHIND HIM. WHEN ASKED ABOUT ANY HISTORY OF MOLESTATION IN [REDACTED] FAMILY, [REDACTED] SAID THERE WAS NONE SHE WAS AWARE OF.

I THEN STOPPED THE INTERVIEW WITH CHRISTINA AND TALKED WITH [REDACTED]

I EXPLAINED TO [REDACTED] THE REASON FOR MY CONTACT AND BECAUSE HE HAD BEEN AT THE HOME OFTEN IN RECENT WEEKS AND ESPECIALLY TODAY HE WAS BEING INVESTIGATED SIMPLY BECAUSE OF ASSOCIATION WITH THE FAMILY. HAROLD SAID HE UNDERSTOOD AND THOUGHT THE DROWNING WAS TERRIBLE.

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I FURTHER EXPLAINED ABOUT THE SUSPECTED MOLESTATION. WHEN I MENTIONED THIS HAROLD SEEMED LIKE HE WAS GENUINELY SHOCKED AT THE THOUGHT OF A SMALL BABY BEING MOLESTED. I THEN TOLD HAROLD TO EXPLAIN WHAT HAD HAPPENED TODAY TO TAYLOR AS HE KNEW IT.

HAROLD [REDACTED] CALLED HIS WIFE TO LET HER KNOW HE WAS ABOUT DONE WITH WORK AND WOULD PICK UP THE KIDS ON HIS WAY HOME. THE TWO OF THEM JOKED A LITTLE BIT.

[REDACTED] SAID AS HE TALKED [REDACTED] CAME OUT OF THE BATHROOM ALONE AND CAME OVER TO HIM. [REDACTED] SAID HE WAS ON THE PHONE IN THE DINING AREA. [REDACTED] WANTED TO TALK TO [REDACTED] SO HE GAVE HER THE PHONE. THE TWO THEN TALKED FOR A WHILE. ON MARCH 18, 1991 I WAS CONTACTED BY [REDACTED] AND ASKED TO COME TO HER HOME TO TALK WITH HER. ON ARRIVAL [REDACTED] TOLD ME SHE WAS CONCERNED ABOUT EVER GETTING BRITANY BACK INTO HER CUSTODY. [REDACTED] SAID SHE LOVES [REDACTED] VERY MUCH AND NEEDS TO HAVE HER HOME. [REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED] WANTS TO COME HOME.

I FURTHER STATED THE MOLESTATION WAS NOT BEING PURSUED ANY LONGER WHICH [REDACTED] WAS ALREADY AWARE OF. I TOLD [REDACTED] I DID NOT THINK THERE WOULD BE A PROBLEM RETURNING [REDACTED] HOME BUT I WAS SURE THERE WOULD BE CERTAIN GUIDELINES SET FORTH FOR A WHILE. I TOLD [REDACTED] IT WOULD UP TO THE COURTS TO DECIDE FOR SURE. [REDACTED] SAID SHE CAN HANDLE WHAT EVER TERMS THE COURT DICTATES BUT SHE CANNOT HANDLE THE LOSS OF HER DAUGHTER [REDACTED]

FOR OFFICIAL AND COMPLETE REPORTS OF THE RESULTS OF THIS EXAMINATION REFER TO THE ATTACHED MEDICAL REPORTS. THE FOLLOWING ASSESSMENT IS BASED ON MY VISUAL OBSERVATIONS AND THROUGH QUESTIONING THOSE PRESENT.

DURING THE INITIAL PART OF THE EXAMINATION [REDACTED] WAS PLACED IN THE SUPINE POSITION (FACE UP). I WITNESSED DR. SHERIDAN EXAM THE VAGINAL AND THE RECTAL AREA OF [REDACTED]. DR. SHERIDAN SAID THE VICTIM'S HYMEN APPEARED TO BE INTACT. THE ONLY QUESTIONABLE IRREGULARITY WAS A SMALL AREA OF SUSPECTED BRUISING NEAR THE VAGINAL OPENING.

A POINT OF CONCERN WAS THE RECTAL AREA IN WHICH THERE APPEARED TO BE A "STAR" SHAPED TEAR WITH SOME SCARING. IN PARTICULAR WERE TWO AREAS OF CONCERN LOCATED AT 12:00 AND AT 5:00 ON THE OUTER PORTION OF THE RECTAL OPENING. ALSO OF CONCERN WERE SIGNS OF ABRASION AND OF SEVERE BRUISING AROUND THE RECTUM.

AS I WATCHED, DR. DITRAGLIA MADE SLIGHT INCISIONS IN THE "BRUISED" AREA OF BOTH THE VAGINAL OPENING AND THE RECTAL OPENING. NO BLEEDING OR DISCOLORATION WAS FOUND IN THE DEEPER SKIN TISSUES AT EITHER LOCATION. DR. DITRAGLIA CONCLUDED THE DISCOLORATION WAS NOT BRUISING BUT POSSIBLY SOME TYPE OF DISCOLORATION/PIGMENTATION OF THE SKIN IN THOSE AREAS, UNCOMMON BUT NOT TRAUMATIC.

THE QUESTION OF THE ABRASIONS (NUMEROUS TINY "DOTS") AROUND THE RECTAL OPENING WAS REFERED TO. BOTH DOCTORS AGREED IT WAS POSSIBLE THE ABRASIONS COULD HAVE BEEN CAUSED BY A DIAPER RASH AND THEN WIPING THE AREA WITH A CLOTH OR A SIMILAR OBJECT.

AS DR. SHERIDAN EXAMINED THE SCARING IN THE RECTAL AREA, SHE ASKED IF THERE WAS ANY HISTORY OF CONSTIPATION OR THE USE OF SUPOSITORIES AND/OR CURRENT MEDICATIONS. I EXPLAINED THERE WAS A HISTORY OF CONSTIPATION IN THE INFANT AT ABOUT THREE TO FOUR MONTHS OF AGE AND THAT SUPOSITORIES WERE USED. THERE WERE NO KNOWN CURRENT ILLNESSES

I REMAINED, AS DID DET. CASKEY, THROUGH OUT THE AUTOPSY OF [REDACTED]. AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE AUTOPSY IT WAS DETERMINED THE CAUSE OF DEATH WAS DROWNING BASED ON A "DIAGNOSIS OF EXCLUSION". DURING THE AUTOPSY DR. DITRAGLIA SHOWED ME AN AREA OF THE RECTUM CALLED THE COLUMNAR/EPITHELIAL JUNCTION. I NOTED THIS AREA TO BE A WHITE LINE OF TISSUE WHICH WAS VERY CROOKED AND UNEVEN. DR. DITRAGLIA POINTED TO SOME SMALL SCARING IN THE EPITHELIAL AREA AND SAID THIS COULD HAVE BEEN CAUSED BY MOST ANYTHING INCLUDING CONSTIPATION. THERE WERE NO SCARS OR INJURIES BEYOND THE ABOVE JUNCTION INDICATING THERE HAD BEEN NO PENETRATION.

DR. DITRAGLIA SUMMED BY SAYING IF THIS INFANT WAS MOLESTED IT WAS NOT BY ANYTHING LARGER THAN A FINGER AND THAT WAS VERY DOUBTFUL. DR.
