SUMMARY OF MEETING: This meeting discussed ceramicware. Topics included definitions of products, technical aspects of production, the use of lead in ceramic glazing and decorations, and whether consumers may experience any exposure to lead through use of ceramicware. The Coalition described standards that must be met for food contact uses of products, and discussed testing and labeling practices for products sold in California under that state's Proposition 65 requirements. Other topics for discussion included whether CPSC regulations for lead in paint are applicable to ceramicware, the definition of children's products and other provisions of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act.
