SUMMARY OF MEETING:

A representative from the International Hospitals Group of the UK requested a meeting to discuss a new package and the proposed changes to the PPPA test protocols. Mr. King discussed the International Hospital Group and their role in designing Easy-Opening Packaging, both child-resistant and conventional. The CPSC staff answered questions about the Commission and the proposed regulations. The meeting was closed and Mr. King showed samples and discussed child-resistant protocol test data for a new packaging design.
