SUMMARY OF MEETING:

In this meeting, technical issues were discussed for the draft standard X-15.46-1 "Standard Specification for Fire Blankets for Consumer Use". Since there was not sufficient attendance for a Subcommittee, the meeting was continued as a "Task Group". The Task Group made revisions to the draft standard, some significant changes were:

1. The addition of a fire performance test to include overhead obstructions for ranges.
2. Use of actual cooking vessels as opposed to cylindrical pans.

A revised draft of the standard will be available for further comment.
