AUTOPSY REPORT

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION: The body is identified by tags affixed to the body. Photographs and footprints are taken for identification. Clothing worn includes a right sock only. A disposable diaper is also worn which is urine soiled. There is no jewelry. The deceased is on a child's blanket.

The body is that of a normally developed white male infant appearing the recorded 4 months of age, 17 inches (43.2 cm) in crown-heel length, 23-3/4 inches (59.8 cm) in crown-rump length, 16-3/4 inches (42.5 cm) chest circumference and 17 inches (43.2 cm) head circumference. Weight is 5900 grams unclothed. Length is at the 25th to 50th percentile and weight between the 10th and 25th percentile for age and gender. Preservation is good in the absence of embalming. Lividity is fixed over the back and normal in color. Rigidity is marked throughout the body with the exception of the neck in which there is no rigidity. The body is cold to touch after refrigeration. Head hair is thin, brown and most thin at the occiput. Body hair is that of a preadolescent in distribution. Eyes are closed with clear corneas, brown irides and pupils are equally dilated. There are no petechial hemorrhages of conjunctiva. The mouth is edentulous. Limbs are equally and symmetrically developed. Genitalia is that of a male with both testes into the scrotal sac. No scars are identified.

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EVIDENCE OF TREATMENT:

1. Endotracheal tube with the tip in the trachea.
2. EKG pads of the body.
3. Two defibrillator pads of the trunk.
4. Transducer of the right first toe.
5. Left ankle with hospital identification band with the name [REDACTED] and another band of the left ankle with the letters "NKDA".
6. Right tibia intraosseous catheter.
7. Left heel sticks.
8. Venipuncture sites of the left foot.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY: None. In particular x-rays of long bones are unremarkable.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION:

HEAD: The scalp, skull, brain and its coverings have no evidence of pre-existing natural disease or injury. Multiple coronal sections of the brain are unremarkable. The brain weighs 820 grams. There is no cerebral edema. Middle ears are inspected. There is no exudate present.

NECK: Cartilagenous and bony structures of the neck are all intact. Trachea and esophagus are clear.

SEROUS CAVITIES: The pleural, pericardial and peritoneal cavities are free of abnormal accumulations of fluid. All surfaces are smooth and glistening.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM: The heart is 30 grams. The heart is normally chambered. Coronary arteries are normally disposed. There are no septal defects. Walls of ventricles are not thickened. There is a closed ductus arteriosis and there is no coarctation of the aorta.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: The right lung is 64 grams and the left lung is 54 grams. Lungs are well inflated and with petechial hemorrhages of pleural surfaces. There is no consolidation of parenchyma. Distal airways are clear. Pulmonary vessels are unremarkable and have normal venous return.

GASTROINTESTINAL SYSTEM: The distal esophagus is unremarkable. The stomach is empty. The mucosa is unremarkable as is the remainder of the digestive tract. The appendix is present.

HEPATOBIILIARY SYSTEM: The liver is 215 grams, reddish-tan and with unremarkable architecture on cut section. The gallbladder is empty.

LYMPHOECTICULAR SYSTEM: The spleen is 24 grams and unremarkable grossly. A thymus gland is present and 41 grams. It has both external and internal petechial hemorrhages. Lymph nodes are unremarkable where seen.

GENITOURINARY SYSTEM: The right kidney is 24 grams and the left kidney is 26 grams. Fetal lobulations are present. Cut surfaces are unremarkable as are the

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collecting systems, ureters and bladder. The bladder is free of urine. Prostate gland is unremarkable.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM: No abnormalities are present in the pituitary, thyroid and adrenal glands. The pancreas is unremarkable.

MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM: No fractures are identified. Skeletal muscles are unremarkable. Body wall fat is 1/4 inch in maximum thickness.

MICROSCOPICS:

HEART: Sections of left ventricle and interventricular septum are unremarkable. There is no evidence of inflammation and there is no fibrosis.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: Sections of lung reveal no significant inflammation of airways and no evidence of pneumonia. Alveoli are well inflated. Lymphoid tissue is prominent. A section of trachea reveals no significant inflammation. There is no edema.

LIVER: There is no fatty change. There is no inflammation of triads.

KIDNEY: Typical infant kidney is present. No inflammation is present.

SPLEEN: Both red and white pulp are unremarkable.

THYMUS GLAND: Internal petechia are present.

PANCREAS: The pancreas is well preserved. Both exocrine and endocrine elements are unremarkable.

ADRENAL GLAND: Cortex and where seen medulla are unremarkable. The adrenal gland is well preserved.

CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM: Sections of cortex and medulla and cerebellum are unremarkable. There is no inflammation of meninges.



FINDINGS:

- I. Body of well developed and well nourished 4 month old white male infant.
 - A. History of prematurity.

CONCLUSION: I am of the opinion that [REDACTED] a 4 month old male, died as a result of sudden infant death syndrome.

PER OFFICER CARTER, PLANO P.D. - MS [REDACTED] LAST SAW INFANT HINKO ALIVE THIS MORNING ABOUT 1:00 A.M. WHEN SHE FED HIM AND PUT HIM BACK TO BED. WHEN SHE CHECKED ON HIM ABOUT 5:35 A.M., SHE FOUND HIM DECEASED IN HIS CRIB AND PHONED 911. BOTH PLANO P.D. AND F.D. RESPONDED TO THE RESDIENCE.

PER KAREN HARRIS, MCP - F.D. BEGAN CPR AT THE RESIDENCE AND TRANSPORTED TO MEDICAL CENTER OF PLANO - ER, ARRIVING AT 8:18 A.M. RESUSCITATION ATTEMPTS WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. DR. [REDACTED] PRONOUNCED AT 8:39 A.M.

PER SCOTT EPPERSON, PLANO P.D. - THE BABY WAS REPORTEDLY FOUND ON HIS STOMACH IN HIS CRIB AGAINST THE BEDDING. HE WILL COLLECT THE BEDDING AND BRING IT TO MCP. HE WILL ALSO COLLECT THE MEDS AND FORMULA.

UPON MY NOTIFICATION AND RESPONSE TO MCP, INFO WAS OBTAINED FROM THE HOSPITAL STAFF, OFFICERS AND MOTHER OF THE INFANT. THE HOSPITAL CHART WAS PICKED-UP.

PER MOTHER - SHE PUT THE INFANT TO BED ABOUT 7:30 P.M. ON HIS PILLOW IN HIS CRIB. HE AWOKE HER ABOUT 12:30 A.M. SHE FED HIM AND PUT HIM TO BED ON HIS STOMACH. IN HIS CRIB ABOUT 1:00 A.M. SHE FOUND HIM DECEASED ABOUT 5:30 A.M. HE HAD SCOOTED UP ON THE MATTRESS AND THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS FACE WAS AGAINST THE SIDE OF THE CRIB PAD. THERE WAS A CLEAR SNOT COMING FROM HIS NOSE (MORE THAN NORMAL). SHE SUSPECTS HE SMOTHERED OR SUFFICATED. THERE WAS A PILLOW AND SOFT TOYS IN THE CRIB.
