

CIRCUMSTANCES OF INCIDENT : The nok feed the decedent 6 oz of formula, which was a normal amount for the decedent at 1500 hours, and then laid him down in his crib for a nap. The decedent was laid down in a full size crib. There was a sheet over the mattress, a blanket spread out on top of the mattress that the decedent was placed on, and a blanket covering the decedent. The decedent was placed on his belly. The decedent did not know how to roll over. The nok then laid down and took a nap. The decedent was never heard making any noises or movement. The nok went back into the decedent's bedroom at 1800 hours and found him lying in the same position, unresponsive. The family picked up the decedent and drove him to the hospital. He arrived in the ER at 1813 hours. Once in the ER, the medical staff stated, the decedent already had lividity noted to his face and he was in rigor mortis. The decedent was pronounced. There were no visible injuries noted to the body at the scene.		
Live Oak PD went to the hosptial for the DOA report, but the incidenet happened in Bexar County. Night CID Detectives are heading to the decedent's home to see if anyone is there, so they can take photos and also to the hospital, to speak with the family.

Liquor and beer bottles were found everywhere. Charged Neglectful supervision and extensive drug history on father [REDACTED] Dec 2006 infant tested positive for cannabanoids and benzodiazepines. June 2009 non related family member, 6 yr old visiting, and fondling child of the next of kin. March 2010 one child had a healing black eye, had previously had two black eyes and soft lump on forehead. Child was determined to have been pushed downstairs by sibling, no adult supervision. All cases were found to be legitimate. Father has extensive drug history and mother has one possession charge.</i>
