

An autopsy on the body of [REDACTED] was performed on June 6, 1990 at 10:00 a.m.

#### EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

CLOTHING: No clothing was submitted for examination.

BODY: The body is that of a black male infant weighing 7.8 pounds (3546 grams) and measuring 16". Rigor mortis is partially developed. The purple lividity is in the front, back and on the right side of the face. The head is slightly elongated anterior and posteriorly. The scalp hair is black and sparse. The anterior fontanelle is open and neither bulging nor retracted. The eyes have brown irides and white sclera. The nose and ears are unremarkable. The gums show no eruptive teeth. The oral mucosa is free of injuries. The chest is normally shape. The abdomen is slightly distended. The umbilicus shows a small hernia. The scrotum is enlarged and bulging on the left side. Therapeutic needle puncture marks are on the right hand, left groin and left ankle. The exterior of the body is otherwise unremarkable.

#### INTERNAL EXAMINATION

HEAD: The reflection of the scalp reveals no scalp contusions. The skull is intact. No intracranial hemorrhage is noted. The brain weighs 398 grams. Sections of the cerebellum, brain stem and cerebellum reveal no abnormality. The intra orbital portion of the optic nerves show no hemorrhage. The inner and middle ears show no grossly visible abnormal exudates on removal of the petrous portion of the temporal bone.

BODY CAVITIES: The peritoneal cavity contained approximately 20 cc. of slightly turbid yellow fluid. The peritoneal surfaces are smooth and slightly dull in appearance. A portions of the intestines has been herniated through the right inguinal canal. This portion of the bowel is reduced easily by pulling out. The abdominal inguinal ring is round and smooth surfaced measuring 3 ml. The sub-serosal fascia near the right abdominal inguinal ring show a focal hemorrhage. The serosal surface of the small and large intestines are smooth and slightly edematous. The intestines is neither dilated nor constricted. The intestinal lumens contain yellow semisolid or semi-liquid contents. The pleural cavities contain no abnormal fluid. The pericardial sac contain a physiologic amount of fluid.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM: The heart weighs 24 grams. The heart and great vessels show no congenital abnormalities.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: The right and left lungs weigh 40 and 36 grams. The pleural surfaces are smooth. The cut surfaces reveal dark reddish-brown soft parenchyma. The trachea and bronchi show pink smooth mucosa.

LIVER: The liver weighs 134 grams. The capsular surface is smooth. The cut surface reveals brown soft parenchyma. The gallbladder contains liquid bile.

SPLEEN: The spleen weighs 10 grams and is unremarkable.

PANCREAS: The pancreas is unremarkable.


ADRENALS: The adrenals are unremarkable.

DIGESTIVE TRACT: The stomach is empty. The intestines are described above.

URINARY SYSTEM: The right and left kidney weigh 19 grams, each. The kidneys are unremarkable. The urinary bladder contains a small amount of urine.

THYMUS: The thymus weigh 14 grams and is unremarkable.

SPECIMENS: Blood, liver, bile, kidney, and brain are submitted for toxicologic analysis. Sections of the major organs and intestines are submitted for microscopic examination.


