The thorax is well developed and symmetric. The abdomen is flat. The anus and back are unremarkable. The penis is circumcised. The testes are bilaterally descended within the scrotum.

The upper and lower extremities are well developed and symmetric without absence of digits. Needle tracks are not identified.

Identifying marks and scars on the body include a .5 x .25 inch hypopigmented scar on the lower half of the right knee. On the undersurface of the chin is a 1 inch linear hypopigmented scar.

Evidence of emergency medical therapy includes a white sponge stuffed into the nostrils, a nasogastric tube, an orotracheal tube properly in place, a yellow neck brace about the neck, defibrillator pads on the anterior chest, and intravenous lines in the right and left antecubital fossae and in the right and left femoral regions. A Foley catheter is in the penile urethra, which is attached to a bag that contains a minimal amount of yellow urine. On the left index finger is a co-oximeter. Three small pads for EKG leads are on the anterior chest. In the right lower leg is an intraosseous catheter. Fresh needle puncture wound sites are noted in both antecubital fossae and in the femoral regions.

No organs have been harvested.

## EVIDENCE OF INJURY

### DESCRIPTION OF BLUNT FORCE INJURIES

**HEAD:** Blood is over the face. On the left side of the face is a horizontal 3 x .5 inch bar of superficial, now somewhat dried abrasion extending from the center of the ear and onto the left cheek. A similar .75 x .2 inch area covers the left earlobe and extends onto the left side of the face. The top of the left ear is partially absent with a jagged laceration, 1.25 x .3 inches. Below the left ear on the left side of the neck is a somewhat triangular-shaped abrasion, 1 x .75 inch. On the right cheek is a spotty 1 x 1 inch area of abrasions. On the right lateral forehead is a .5 x .2 inch area of linear abrasions. A large 3 x .75 x 3 inch irregular abrasion involves the top half of the right ear, and extends posteriorly over the scalp. Just anterior and slightly superior to this is a 1 x .25 inch scalp abrasion. Below the right ear and on the right side of the neck is a 1.5 x 1.75 inch abrasion. On the mid right neck is a 1 x .75 inch irregular abrasion. On the right cheek just above the angle of the right jaw is a 1 x .5 inch area of streak-type abrasion, and anterior to that is a .75 x .5 inch abrasion.

Internal examination reveals a large 6 x 7 inch area of subgaleal contusion and hemorrhage, which extends over much of the right parietal and posterior scalp. A 2 x 1 inch area of subgaleal hemorrhage and contusion is noted on the left inferior temporal and parietal scalp. Reflection of the scalp and removal of the calvarium shows

diffuse subarachnoid hemorrhage over much of the surface of the brain and an approximately 20 cc subdural hemorrhage, which is over the right superior and base of the brain. Removal of the brain reveals a complete hinge fracture extending through the ridge between right and left middle cranial fossae and the posterior cranial fossa with comminuted fractures extending into both the right and left posterior cranial fossa. These fractures are displaced and cause multiple lacerations of the right and left base of the cerebrum and the brain stem extending into the pons over a 3 x 3 inch area. The brain is edematous, shows diffuse subarachnoid hemorrhage, and has somewhat flattening of the gyri and loss of the sulci.

**EXTREMITIES:** In addition to injuries of the head, there is also a .75 x .4 inch area of abrasion on the medial to ventral surface the mid left thumb. Below the left knee is a .75 x .5 inch purple contusion, and on the mid right shin is a .3 inch purple contusion.

### INTERNAL EXAMINATION

**BODY CAVITIES:** No adhesions or abnormal collections of fluids are in any of the body cavities, other than the 20 cc subdural hemorrhage previously described. All body organs are present in normal and anatomic position. The subcutaneous fat layer of the abdominal wall is 2 cm thick.

**HEAD (CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM):** The brain weighs 1650 grams. The dura mater is no longer intact over the base of the brain due to a laceration secondary to fractures of the base of the skull. The falx cerebri is intact. The leptomeninges are thin and delicate, and there is diffuse subarachnoid hemorrhage over most of the surface of the brain as previously described. There is also a 20 cc subdural hemorrhage. The cerebral hemispheres are symmetric; however, there is flattening of the gyri and narrowing of the sulci due to edema. The structures at the base of the brain, including cranial nerves and blood vessels, are intact, except for extensive lacerations involving a 3 x 3 inch area of the base of the cerebellum and the brain stem extending onto pons. Sections through the cerebral hemispheres do not reveal other lesions within the cortex, subcortical white matter, or deep parenchyma of either hemisphere. The cerebral ventricles are of normal caliber. Sections through the brain stem and cerebellum are otherwise unremarkable. The spinal cord is not examined.

**NECK:** Examination of the soft tissues of the neck, including strap muscles and large vessels, reveals no abnormalities. The hyoid bone and larynx are intact. The tongue is normal.

**CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM:** The heart weighs 180 grams. The pericardial surfaces are smooth, glistening, and unremarkable, except for a few scattered petechiae. The pericardial sac is free of significant fluid and adhesions. The coronary arteries arise normally and follow the usual distribution of a right dominant pattern with no significant atherosclerotic stenosis. The chambers and valves bear the usual size/position relationship, except there is slight dilatation of the right ventricle. The circumferences of the cardiac valves are as follows: Tricuspid 11.0 cm, Pulmonic 6.0 cm, Mitral 8.0 cm, and Aortic 4.5 cm. The myocardium on serial sectioning is red-brown, firm, and does not show obvious areas of necrosis or fibrosis. The atrial and ventricular septa are intact. The thickness of the left ventricular free wall is 10 mm and the right is 3 mm. The aorta and its major branches arise normally and follow the usual course with no significant atherosclerosis. The vena cava and its major tributaries return to the heart in the usual distribution and are unremarkable.

**RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:** The right and left lungs weigh 310 and 270 grams, respectively. The upper and lower airways are patent, and the mucosal surfaces are pink-tan. The pleural surfaces are smooth, glistening, and unremarkable. The pulmonary parenchyma on serial sectioning is salmon pink and exudes a minimal amount of bloody, frothy fluid. The pulmonary arteries are normally developed and patent.

**LIVER AND BILIARY SYSTEM:** The liver weighs 530 grams. The hepatic capsule is smooth, glistening, and intact covering a red-brown parenchyma. The gallbladder contains viscid bile.

**ALIMENTARY TRACT:** The esophagus is lined by gray-white smooth mucosa. The gastric mucosa is arranged in the usual rugal folds, and the lumen contains 30 cc of tan-red fluid. The small and large bowel are unremarkable. The appendix is present. The pancreas has a normal pink-tan lobulated appearance, and the ducts are clear.

**GENITOURINARY TRACT:** The right and left kidneys weigh 90 grams, each. The renal capsules are smooth, thin, semitransparent, and strip with ease from the underlying smooth, red-brown, firm cortical surfaces. The cortices are sharply delineated from the underlying medullary pyramids. The calyces, pelves, and ureters are unremarkable. The urinary bladder is empty; the mucosa is white-tan and smooth. The prostate is unremarkable.

**RETICULOENDOTHELIAL SYSTEM:** The spleen weighs 140 grams and has a smooth, intact, dark red-purple capsule covering a red-purple, moderately firm parenchyma. The regional lymph nodes appear normal.

**ENDOCRINE SYSTEM:** The pituitary, thyroid, and adrenal glands are unremarkable. The thymus is present and weighs 40 grams. It consists of a white-tan, somewhat lobulated mass of tissue, which does not show petechiae or injury.

**MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM:** The bony framework, supporting musculature, and soft tissues are not unusual away from the areas of injury.

OPINION

This 7-year-old Caucasian male, Austin Reuter, died of multiple blunt force injuries of the head, including extensive skull fracture with injury to the brain.

According to investigative reports, the decedent sustained these injuries as the driver of a "Club car," which the family described as a "cross between a Gator and a golf cart". When he did not return to the house, the family went looking for him and found him in the farm field underneath the Club car. The stepfather removed the Club car and started CPR while the mother called 911. Bellevue Ambulance responded to the scene and transported the decedent to Mercy Hospital in Dubuque, where resuscitative measures were unsuccessful, and the decedent was pronounced dead. It appeared from the scene investigation that the decedent had been attempting to drive the Club car up a fairly steep embankment and was on a partially gravel drive at the time that it rolled over. The decedent lived on a farm with his mother, sister, and stepfather.

The decedent had a medical history of borderline asthma and seasonal allergies.

The manner of death is **ACCIDENT**.

**HEART:** Representative sections of both the right and left ventricles disclose intact myocardial fibers. No myocarditis, or other abnormality is identified.

**LUNGS:** Representative sections from both lungs show intact alveoli with mild vascular congestion. In focal areas the alveoli are filled with blood. Rare lymphoid nodules are seen.

**LIVER:** A section of the liver shows a normal architectural pattern. The sinusoids are mildly congested.

**PANCREAS:** Acinar and islet cells are arranged in a normal architectural pattern with no significant histopathologic change.

**SPLEEN:** The red pulp is congested. The white pulp contains the usual mantle and marginal zones.

**ADRENALS:** There is relative preservation of cortical and medullary cells without significant histopathological change.

**KIDNEYS:** Sections from both kidneys show diffuse vascular congestion. No other significant diagnostic abnormality is seen.


**BRAIN:** Representative sections of the brain show acute subarachnoid hemorrhage and multi-focal areas of acute hemorrhage in the parenchyma.




## Iowa boy, 7, killed doing farm chores

The information in this report was based on information received by the police department and the coroner's office. Contact with the victims' next-of-kin or other victims were not successful.

On Saturday, May 12, 2012, in Erie County, Amity Township, PA, the weather condition was clear and the temperature was 64 degrees when the victim, an 8-year-old female driver, was operating a 4-wheeled utility vehicle in a field and was not wearing a helmet or a seatbelt. She was accompanied by two other passengers, a 9-year-old female, a 49-year-old male and they were not wearing helmets or seatbelts.

The victim traveled downhill, failed to maintain control and caused the vehicle to roll over. She was ejected and the vehicle landed on her. She was fatally injured. Her passengers were not severely injured. They were taken to a hospital where they were treated and released.

911 was contacted. Paramedics and fire/EMT personnel arrived on the scene. Fire/EMT personnel performed CPR on the victim to no avail. The victim died due to her injuries. Her height and weight was not known. Her cause of death was multiple blunt force traumas.
