SUMMARY OF MEETING:

A series of closed meetings were held at the request of four member companies of the Cosmetic, Toiletry, and Fragrance Association (CTFA). The CPSC staff met with each company separately. The four companies were Platex Products, Johnson and Johnson, Colgate-Palmolive, and Avon.

Each company discussed the formulation(s) of the product(s) that would be impacted by a rule to require child-resistant packaging of products that contain more than 10% hydrocarbons. The companies discussed the market, the current packaging, and potential problems with child-resistant packaging. Each company discussed poisoning incidents reported to their companies.
