SUMMARY OF CONVERSATION:

Sue Kyle referred Mr. Miller to me. I returned his call and he said that FDA had told him informally that they did not have jurisdiction over the "efacials" and wanted to know if CPSC did. I told him we would not have jurisdiction if FDA had jurisdiction over it either as a medical device or a cosmetic. Otherwise, CPSC would have jurisdiction. I suggested that he write for an opinion from FDA's Chief Counsel's office.
