MEETING SUMMARY:

- Representatives from the gas furnace industry met with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) staff, at the CPSC Directorate for Laboratory Sciences facility, to witness the CPSC's furnace emissions test setup.
- The furnace industry representatives indicated they would provide comments on the test setup through the Gas Appliance Manufacturers Association within one month from the date of the meeting.
- No tests were conducted during the meeting.
- The manufacturing representative for the furnace installed at the time of the meeting stayed an extra day (March 26, 1999) to witness the operation of the furnace.
- The manufacturing representative stated he was satisfied that the furnace was installed and operating properly.
- The manufacturing representative also stated that staff should determine the heating value of the natural gas fueling the furnace in order to determine a more accurate input rate.
