Final Rule: PPPA Rule Requiring Child-Resistant Packaging for Imidazolines
(Briefing package dated November 8, 2012, OS No. 4734)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve publication of the final rule as drafted in the *Federal Register*. Pursuant to the Poison Prevention Packaging Act of 1970 ("PPPA"), the final rule requires child-resistant packaging for any over-the-counter or prescription drug product containing the equivalent of 0.08 milligrams or more of an imidazoline, a class of drugs that includes tetrahydrozoline, naphazoline, oxymetazoline and xylometazoline, in a single package.
