INTERROGATORY NO. 18: Identify any written, oral and/or recorded statements regarding the incident which is the subject of your lawsuit.



COMES NOW, Randal Crane, Plaintiff, complaining of Riva Sport, Inc., Ski Limited Enterprises, Inc., Christopher Bradley, and James Bradley, Defendants, and would respectfully show:

Parties

I.

Plaintiff Randal Crane is a resident of Limestone County, Texas.

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II.

Defendant Riva Sport, Inc. is a Nevada corporation doing business in Texas as defined under TEX. CIV. PRACT. & REM. CODE § 17.044. Defendant Riva Sport, Inc., however, has failed to appoint or maintain a registered agent in Texas. Defendant Riva Sport, Inc. is therefore deemed pursuant to TEX. BUS. CORP. ACT. ANN. art. 2.11 as well as TEX. CIV. PRACT. & REM. CODE § 17.044 to have appointed the Texas Secretary of State as its agent upon whom any such process, notice, complaint, or demand may be served. Service of this process including the Citation and Petition may be made upon Defendant Riva Sport, Inc. in accordance with TEX. CIV. PRACT. & REM. CODE § 17.026 by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by otherwise delivering to and leaving with the Honorable John Hanna, Secretary of State (or with his Assistant Secretary of State, or with any clerk having charge of the Corporation Department of his office) at the office of the Secretary of State, Statutory Documents Section, P.O. Jurisdiction

VI.

Plaintiff brings suit for all damages to which he is entitled by law. Plaintiff's damages are within the jurisdictional limits of this Court.

Venue

VII.

James Bradley and Christopher Bradley are natural persons residing in Limestone County, Texas. Venue is therefore proper in Limestone County as to Defendants James Bradley and Christopher Bradley pursuant to TEX. CIV. PRACT. & REM. CODE § 15.001. Plaintiff has properly joined all Defendants and all claims in the above styled and numbered cause in Limestone County, Texas. Venue is therefore proper for all Defendants pursuant to TEX. CIV. PRACT. & REM. CODE § 15.061.

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Facts of Case

VIII.

On or about May 31, 1993, at Lake Limestone in Limestone County, Texas Plaintiff Randal Crane suffered an injury to his left eye when he was struck in the face by an Aqua Sling water balloon. This water balloon was launched from an Aqua Sling water balloon sling shot which was under the control of Defendants Christopher Bradley and James Bradley. Said Defendants' failure to use ordinary care in the use of this water balloon and sling shot was a proximate cause of this accident and Plaintiff's resulting injury.

IX.

This Aqua Sling water balloon (Model B-12) and sling shot (Competition Model: 200 YD Range) were designed, manufactured, marketed, or sold by Defendants Riva Sport, Inc. and Ski Limited Enterprises, Inc. Said Defendants were engaged in the business of selling balloons and sling shots of the models in question as an integrated or combined consumer product. This product, consisting of the balloon and sling shot, was unreasonably dangerous at the time it left said Defendants' possession because of design and well as marketing defects. Said Defendants' failure to use ordinary care in designing and marketing this product as well as the defects in this product were a proximate or a producing cause of this accident and Plaintiff's resulting injury.

Causes of Action

X.

Plaintiff bases his causes of action in part upon negligence, breach of express and implied warranty, and strict products' liability as those terms are defined and

understood under the common law and statutes of Texas including TEX. BUS. & COM. CODE ANN. §§ 2.314 & 2.315. Plaintiff would show that the defective condition of Defendants' product, which rendered it unreasonably dangerous or unfit, as well as Defendants' conduct, as set forth herein and otherwise, were each and all a proximate or producing cause of the occurrence or injury in question and Plaintiff's damages resulting from the occurrence or injury in question. All conditions precedent to the filing of this lawsuit have been performed or have occurred.

Damages

XI.

Plaintiff has suffered damages in the past as well as in the future, for which prejudgment interest is owed. These damages include physical pain, mental anguish, loss of earnings or earning capacity, disfigurement, physical or visual impairment, and reasonable expenses for necessary medical care.

Trial by Jury

XII.

Plaintiff hereby requests a trial by jury. Plaintiff has deposited the jury fee with the clerk of this court and complied with TEX. R. CIV. P. 216.

Prayer for Relief

XIII.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Plaintiff prays for trial by jury and judgment against Defendants, jointly and severally, for all damages to which Plaintiff is entitled by law, prejudgment and postjudgment interest, costs of court, and such

other and further relief, general and special, legal and equitable, to which Plaintiffs
justly entitled.


