**SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL:**

**The task group considered proposed requirements for a draft Standard**

**Consumer Safety Specification for Baby Monitor Labeling. Specific requirements for text and pictograms for warning labels on the power cord and enclosure were considered. The warning label for the power cord is to be placed within 4 inches of the plug connection to the camera or monitor.**

**Deficiencies with the proposed icon were discussed. Mr. Pereira volunteered to provide the task group with new icons that would address concerns.**

**The task group worked on requirements for baby monitors with shielded or enclosed power cords that are intended to be mounted on or within 3 feet of the occupant retention area. Mr. Doug Lee requested that 6.1 be revised to include tension and force requirements. Mr. Paolo would review the stationary activity center standard language and recommend changes. The task group agreed that a different label would be needed for these types of monitors. Mr. Fernandes volunteered to draft requirements for this label.**
