**SUMMARY OF MEETING:** Dr. Masiakos discussed ATV injury prevention, and the Massachusetts ATV law establishing a minimum age for ATV use. Dr. Masiakos conveyed his concerns and the concerns of other medical associations about the many deaths and traumas associated with the use ATVs by children. Dr. Masiakos and Dr. Bowman offered their assistance to the CPSC in any efforts to address ATV-related injuries and deaths. CPSC staff reviewed CPSC's work on this issue, and the impact of the ATV provisions in the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008.
