SUMMARY OF MEETING: The ASTM task group discussed when inclined sleep products need a restraint, whether restraints can be a hazard in certain instances, and how to define restraints and containment systems. The task group agreed that inclined sleepers should have sides that contain an infant and that additional restraints such as straps with buckles may also be allowed but not required. The task group chairman will create a proposal for the next subcommittee meeting in October.
