SUMMARY OF MEETING: Members of the Power Tool Institute gave a brief background of their organization and advances they have made in the safety of

the product that their members sell. They also asked that the Commission not renew its rulemaking on Saw Stop technology because the new UL standard sufficiently addresses the hazards associated with table saws. The PTI representatives also had monopoly concerns with the Saw Stop technology and discussed the rise in costs for table saws if such technology was required by the Commission.
