Establishment of a Public Consumer Product Safety Incident Database: Notice of Public Workshop
(Briefing package dated December 7, 2009)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to issue the draft *Federal Register* notice with changes that announces a two-day workshop, to be held on January 11 and 12, 2009, to receive views from all interested parties on establishing a public consumer product safety incident database. The workshop seeks to gather information from stakeholders on five aspects of the public database: data analysis and reporting; reports of harm; manufacturer notification and response, additional database content; and materially inaccurate information. Section 212 of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 ("CPSIA")(Pub. Law 110-314) amended the Consumer Product Safety Act ("CPSA") to create a new section 6A of the CPSA, titled "Publicly Available Consumer Product Safety Information Database." Section 6A(a)(1) of the CPSA states that the Commission shall "establish and maintain a database on the safety of consumer products, and other products or substances regulated the Commission..."
