SUMMARY OF MEETING: The meeting occurred via conference call and the representatives of NEMA expressed the concerns of their industry on RILA's proposed safety audit program. They expressed that RILA's program does not apply well to their industry and will increase costs without advancing safety. When asked about their participation in the development of the standard, the NEMA representatives stated that they were not involved in the development of the initial standard but they hope to be involved in the more specific guidelines that will apply to their industry. NEMA thought that the standard, as it applied to

electrical products, was overbroad and nothing in the proposed safety standard would have prevented a recall in the past year.
