Requirements for Consumer Registration of Durable Infant or Toddler Products; Notice of Proposed Rulemaking
(Briefing package dated May 20, 2009, OS No. 3904)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to approve the *Federal Register* notice as drafted that issues a notice of proposed rulemaking proposing a rule under section 104(d) of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act. Section 104(d) directs the Commission to issue a rule requiring manufacturers of durable infant or toddler products to provide consumers with registration forms with each such product, keep records of consumers' contact information and permanently mark their products with identifying information.
