On May 12, 2009, the Commission issued a stay of enforcement of the lead content limits for certain parts of youth motorized recreational vehicles until May 1, 2011 (74 FR 22154). The stay, among other things, requires manufacturers to file, no later than July 11, 2009, a report on the component parts of the recreational vehicles made of metal accessible to children, and the measurement of the lead content based on representative samples of each part. The industry has requested an extension of time to comply with this filing requirement until after August 14, 2009.
