SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The Home Fashion Products Association (HFPA) met on February 9, 2005. A portion of their business meeting focused on flammability and home textile issues. Mr. Robert Leo of Meeks & Sheppard, Counsel to the HFPA, provided an overview of rulemaking proceedings involving the flammability of mattresses, bedding and upholstered furniture.

CPSC staff, Allyson Tenney, updated the group on current CPSC rulemaking projects, the notice of proposed rulemaking (NPR) and proposed standard for mattresses, and the advance notice of proposed rulemaking (ANPR) for bedclothes. The presentations were followed by a question and answer session, providing an opportunity for attendees from home textile suppliers and retailers to address specific questions.
