
Dear Customer Service:

We are writing to inform you that your smoke detector Model No. SA88 did not function during an emergency. We had a small fire in the room directly adjacent to the detector shortly after installing a brand new battery. The detector did not respond despite fact that it was located three feet from the open door of the smoke filled room.

After the incident, we tested the alarm using both the push button and a burning match and at which time it made a barely audible beep. Additional part numbers from inside of the device are; 1111 151 and P4715, both printed in blue ink on the buzzer's plastic cover.

We have been buying your smoke detectors for years, installing numerous units in every place we have lived, leaving them in place when we move. We have never needed the devices to work before, and the one time where it may have saved our lives, it malfunctioned. We are putting you on notice that this has happened, and that we have since replaced the unit and battery. We request compensation for the new unit (\$20.00) and are requesting compensation for our fright and some of the smoke damage which may have been avoided (\$300.) We look forward to your response, and will gladly turn the unit over to you once we have settled this matter.
