ITEM:

Petition to Exempt Powder Formulations of Colesevelam Hydrochloride (Welchol®)(PP 10-1) and Sevelamer Carbonate (Renvela®)(PP 10-2) from Special Packaging Requirements of the Poison Prevention Packaging Act
(Briefing package dated February 2, 2011)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to grant two petitions requesting exemption from special packaging requirements under the Poison Prevention Packaging Act and approve publication in the *Federal Register* of the draft notice of proposed rulemaking without change for: (A) petition PP 10-1 submitted by Daiichi Sankyo, Inc., for powder formulations of colesevelam hydrochloride (Welchol®); and (B) petition PP 10-2 requesting exemption for powder formulations of Sevelamer Carbonate (Renvela®).
