Petition CP 02-4/HP 02-1 requesting ban of the sale of adult-size four-wheel all-terrain vehicles sold for the use of children under 16 years of age

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve without change the draft Federal Register notice inviting comments on Petition CP 02-4/HP 02-1 from the Consumer Federation of America (and other groups, American Academy of Pediatrics, the American College of Emergency Physicians, Bluewater Network, the Center for Injury Research and Policy, the Danny Foundation for Crib and Child Product Safety, Kids in Danger, National Association of Orthopedic Nurses, and U.S. Public Interest Research Group) requesting the Commission to issue a rule banning the sale of adult-size four-wheel all-terrain vehicles sold for the use of children under 16 years of age.
