Request by Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America for Thirty-day Extension of Comment Period on Petition PP 03-1, Petition Requesting Amendment to Child-Resistance Testing Pass/Fail Criterion for Unit Dose Packaging (Briefing package dated July 25, 2003, OS#3046)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to deny the request for an extension and issue a denial letter from the General Counsel. The Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) trade association requested a thirty-day extension of the comment period on Petition PP 03-1, Petition Requesting Amendment to Child-Resistance Testing Pass/Fail Criterion for Unit Dose Packaging.
