Federal Register Notice Announcing Public Meeting about Cigarette Lighter Petition

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve without change the draft Federal Register notice announcing a Commission briefing on the cigarette lighter petition (CP 02-1) and asking for oral presentations from interested parties at the meeting on the petition or the staff's briefing package. Petition CP 02-1 requested that the Commission adopt a voluntary standard for cigarette lighters, ASTM F-400, as a mandatory standard under the Consumer Product Safety Act. The Commission's staff briefing package recommends that the commission deny the petition. The notice also invites written submissions in addition to, or instead of, oral presentations to be accepted until October 14, 2004.
