**SUMMARY OF MEETING: Messrs. Wilson and Locker discussed the process by which CPSC staff and industry representatives have tried to develop a process for portable bed rails. Mr. Locker said that the major difficulty has been agreeing on a performance standard that adequately reduced the risk of entrapment to children under two, for whom the product was not intended, while not creating an entrapment hazard for children aged two to five, for whom the product is intended.**
