**SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL:** Returned call to Michael Brown 202-237-5733, who requested a meeting with CPSC on behalf of his clients, the chemical manufacturers of CCA (Arch, Osmose, and CSI). The purpose of the meeting would be to allow a presentation by Barbara Beck on the study protocols that have been developed by his client on CCA wood, bioavailability, etc. so that the CPSC understands what studies will be undertaken as these protocols have already been "blessed" by the EPA. I explained to Mr. Brown that this presentation would be welcomed as long as he understood that it would be a public meeting. Also explained that in August, 2002, we provided ACC and his client written comments on the dislodgeable arsenic on wood protocol and that we would not be providing any further comments on them at this meeting.
