SUMMARY OF MEETING: F08.10.19 Bicycle Accessories Meeting - Discussed passage of VIN Standard approved May 10 to be assigned ASTM F2268.

F08.10.04 Bicycle Frames - Addressed negative votes on draft Test Method for Bicycle Frames.

F08.10.01 Handlebars & Stems - Roundtable discussion on ideas looked at to address handlebar end blunt abdominal trauma impacts. Desired solution would increase size of handlebar ends, but most be something that is durable and won't tear off within a year. Recommended permanently capping handlebar ends as a partial solution. This would increase surface area of impact and help decrease coring injuries. Group decided to review the current ISO bicycle standard which increased the diameter of the handlebar grips at the end and develop a draft recommendation to be circulated for comment.

F08.10.02 Suspension and Forks - Addressed one negative comment on draft fork test method. Discussed failure criteria.

Meeting adjourned. Next meeting to be in conjunction with the Interbike convention in Las Vegas in October 2003.
