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**Summary of Meeting**

Issues discussed: Main issue discussed was test procedure for the pendulum test and static load test. Committee decided that we did need a static load test because it measured a different amount of force exerted on the fall prevention device (window guard).

It was determined that the committee wanted some testing done to make sure that the 2 tests were the correct ones. Leslie Locke's Daryl Hower volunteered his company to do the testing.

Another issue discussed was the warning information sheet. The manufacturer is now responsible for getting this information to the public by printing it on the packaging, or including it in the packaging.

Future schedule: Tentative May 4, 1998 meeting set up if committee needs to discuss test procedure results. If not, around the May 1, 1998 the standard goes to ballot. There is a 30 day turn around time. Committee meeting June 15, 1998 to discuss ballot comments.
