Summary of Meeting

The meeting was chaired by Mr. John Blair from DuPont as an officer of ASTM F15. The purpose of the meeting was to consider two negatives received on the January 8, 1999, ballot to make PS110 "Provisional Safety Specification for Chests, Door Chests and Dressers" a full consensus standard.

The subcommittee members present voted to withdraw the ballot in order to remove balloted changes to the provisional standard which allowed the furniture to be tied to the wall, via a strap or some sort of hardware included with the furniture, while the unit was being tested. One negative ballot had found this change unacceptable, as had a comment submitted by CPSC staff. Other editorial and clarification changes were accepted by those present and will be incorporated into the rebalot.

Mr. Blair announced that he wished to step down as chairman. Mr. Tom Lowry of Ethan Allen, Inc., was elected subcommittee chairman.

The subcommittee discussed developing a standard for portable appliance carts (microwave and TV carts). It was decided that this was within the scope of the subcommittee. A task group headed by Mr. David Dietrich of Sauder Woodworking was set up to develop a draft standard

The next meeting time was tentatively set for July, after the full consensus standard has been rebalotted and votes received. The task group for appliance carts will have a draft standard prepared for the next meeting.
