**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The task group discussed proposed warning language suggested by CPSC staff last fall.

**Fall Hazard:** Members of the task group felt the two hazard avoidance statements on the proposal were redundant and minor changes were suggested in the wording.

**Suffocation hazard:** The task group discussed the new, proposed suffocation warning at length. Concerns were raised regarding the difference between different types of add-on changing units (e.g., play yard accessory changing

tables vs. solid add-on units designed to convert the top of a dresser into a changing table). In addition, some members of the task group expressed that the suffocation warning should be slightly modified depending on the type of changing product.

**Format:** The issue of warning format was deferred pending the forthcoming proposal of the Ad Hoc Wording Task Group.
