Summary of Meeting:

This task group is focused on developing a standard for wall beds. The task group continued discussion from the previous meeting on next steps in the development of the standard.

The primary focus of the meeting was to discuss potential performance requirements to be incorporated in the new standard. One member presented how their company currently tests wall beds to the performance requirements in ISO 10131 Foldaway Beds. This included the test procedure and setup for the following sections:

- 5.4 Folding Fittings
- 5.5 Strength and Durability
 - 5.5.1 Strength and durability of the foldable part
 - 5.5.2 Horizontal durability test
 - 5.5.3 Unintended Closing
 - 5.5.4 Unintended Opening

Another member gave an overview of an incident where the wall bed frame detached from the wall due to insufficient attachment to thin wall studs. Before the next meeting, the Chair will send a working document of the current requirements developed and task group members will be able to make edits and comments.
