SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Task group chair, Rachael Shagot, recapped the status of ongoing work with various task groups: Restraints group will try to fit in one more meeting before April ASTM mtg, Collapse group is meeting next week [date still TBD], self-folding stairs ready to present in April, and warning labels up for discussion today.

The task group discussed proposed warning formatting suggested by CPSC staff:

Formatting: Single warning statements do not require bullets, but should still be set apart from the rest of the paragraph. (Bullets may or may not be used.) Also ok for separate hazard warnings to be divided just by white space (no separating divider line required.) Ad Hoc committee rules were shared with the group.

Different Lables for Different Add-On Unit Types: The task group discussed the need for a different definition for play yard accessory/add-on changing tables vs. solid add-on units deigned to convert the top of a dresser into a changing table. Will add a definition for "non-rigid changing unit" to refer to units like play yard add-on changing accessories (with soft sides and/or bottom). Changing tables will receive one label, all other non-rigid changing units (contoured pads & add-on accessories) will get another label which also addresses attachment and suffocation hazards unique to those products. Manufacturers will be able to select which product language is correct reference for their product (wording on labels is SUGGESTED wording, not EXACT.) Hope Nesteruk, CPSC, will send out reworked labels to the group based on today's discussion.

Minor revisions to language were agreed upon for suffocation hazard.
