### Summary of Meeting:

The meeting was officially opened by Mr. Steven Anzaroot, the subcommittee chair. After attendees completed introductions, the group approved the meeting agenda and prior minutes. The chair noted that there were no ballot results to discuss and reported that there had been no activity from the Task Groups (Retractable Gates and Gate Accessories). As a result, the group agreed to postpone further discussion of these Task Groups until new developments arise.

During the new business portion of the meeting, a member raised concerns regarding incidents involving scissoring, pinching, and protrusions associated with gates. The member referenced cases reported to SaferProducts.gov and NEISS, and suggested the group consider adopting requirements from European and Canadian standards to help prevent such incidents. CPSC staff responded that recent incident data reviews had not identified these issues, but requested the member share their supporting data for further review. The committee agreed to establish a Task Group to examine the incident data and evaluate whether revisions or new requirements should be incorporated into the standard.

Lastly, CPSC staff also notified the attendees that the Commission had voted to adopt the updated gates standard, ASTM 1004-25. The Direct Final Rule updating 16 CFR part 1239 will take effect on July 19, 2026.

### Next Steps:

CPSC staff will participate in the newly formed Task Group and attend the upcoming ASTM juvenile products subcommittee meetings, which are scheduled for October 26 through October 28, 2026.
