Summary of Meeting:

The ASTM F15.59 Children's Step Stools and Standing Towers Task Group (TG) discussed the following aspects related to the draft standard for children's step stools:

- The TG discussed adding language to distinguish between step stools and standing towers.
- The TG discussed adding a definition for "rigid" from toys standard. CPSC staff suggested using the definition of "rigid" from ASTM D2240. The TG agreed.
- The TG discussed updating the structural integrity requirements to include UV-testing (for degradation).
- The TG discussed bounded openings and which heights should apply to guardrails. The TG agreed to look at incident data and discuss later.
- The TG discussed whether fatigue testing should be done before static load testing. The TG agreed to use the language from the children's chairs standard.¹
- The TG discussed categorizing incident data related to children's step stools. A few participants will
 work together to review the data.

Next Steps:

The Task Group for Children's Step Stools plans to meet June 5, 2025, from 3:00–4:30 PM (ET), to continue working on the draft standard.
