This subcommittee meeting focused on work conducted by the two task groups (TG) for warning labels and performance requirements.

The warning labels group presented the draft for the warning text and the pictogram to accompany them based on input from the last subcommittee meeting. CPSC staff provided input on the language in the draft, as well as suggestions on where those warnings should be located on the product and retail package.

The subcommittee also reviewed progress from the performance requirements TG. The next performance requirements TG meeting was scheduled for 5/4/2026 but this meeting will be postponed to give the members enough time to incorporate feedback from this subcommittee meeting into the draft.

CPSC staff provided an updated on the neck float rule, which becomes effective 6/15/26. At the time of this meeting, no third-party labs had applied for accreditation to test to 16 CFR 1250.5. Due to this lack of laboratory capacity, staff informed the subcommittee that the Commission had approved a 60-day extension of the date by which neck floats must be tested and certified to 16 CFR 1250.5. While all requirements must still be met by 6/15/26, the new deadline for certification requirements is 8/16/26.
