This was the second meeting of the F15.07 Buoyancy Aids for Children Subcommittee. Its primary purpose was to discuss the proposed scope of the standard, and to review work performed by the task groups since the last subcommittee meeting in March.

The subcommittee began discussion by considering whether to include products already approved by the USCG in the scope of this proposed standard. Subcommittee members brought up that there is precedence for joint coverage of certain products, such as how car seats fall under the jurisdiction of both NHTSA and CPSC. Subcommittee members asked staff if there was incident data available involving USCG-approved products, particularly in pools. Staff informed the subcommittee that we were not certain if incidents involving USCG-approved devices would be included among the sources data is pulled from concerning consumer products, but that we would look into it.

Both TGs presented the work they have conducted over the past months since the last subcommittee meeting. Subcommittee members had suggestions for the performance requirement group to consider regarding the seam strength test for vinyl.

The TGs will continue to meet between now and the next subcommittee meeting. Further conversation regarding the scope will move over to the collaborative workspace.
