Summary of Meeting:

The UL 410 task group convened to review the UL 410 standard (Standard for Slip Resistance of Floor Surface Materials), address recent negative comments arising from a review cycle, and plan how to respond collectively. Substantive negative comments included concerns about the James Machine, a 0.5 threshold coefficient of friction (COF), static vs dynamic COF testing, and dry versus wet testing. The group agreed to provide individual rebuttals and submit them to the chair. The chair will then compile a consolidated response for UL, indicating which comments are non-persuasive and why.
