Summary of Meeting:

The Sub Task Group (STG) for Markings and Instructions met to discuss the following:

- The Chair presented a spreadsheet showing different sections of the UL 141 standard related to markings and/or instructions. The STG discussed revisions to each section. CPSC staff suggested referencing ANSI Z535.6.¹ The STG agreed.
- The group deliberated whether it would be more time efficient to postpone all meetings focused on
 markings and instructions until consensus is reached on testing/design requirements for steamers. The
 rationale was that any newly agreed upon design changes might require the STG to rediscuss
 previously settled issues pertaining to markings or instructions. In the interest of saving time, the STG
 agreed to suspend its meetings until the testing and design requirements are further developed.

Next Steps:

The STG has suspended meetings and will resume discussing markings and instructions after the testing/design requirements for handheld steamers are further developed in the larger Task Group or in the Sub Task Group for Testing Steamers.
