The meeting opened with a discussion emphasizing the importance of lithium-ion (Li-ion) battery safety and the role of ULSE in developing related safety standards. ULSE highlighted the areas where they believe they are leading and shared updates on several ongoing projects.

The conversation then transitioned to CPSC overviewing the Commission's efforts to develop a Li-ion safety standards.

ULSE requested CPSC's support for their initiatives and invited feedback on various approaches to advancing new Li-ion safety standards.

The discussion circled back to the broader importance of Li-ion safety, with ULSE expressing a willingness to share incident data. They also addressed the issue of counterfeit product certificates and explained how to verify whether a product is UL Certified or UL Listed.

The meeting concluded with insights into recent changes at the CPSC.
