### **Summary of Meeting:**

This was a meeting of just the Static Testing Task Group; recent meetings have included both the Static Testing Task Group and the Dynamic Testing Task Group. Task group members discussed how to specify the pass/fail criterion for testing. Task group members revised the draft language from a requirement that the anti-tip device not have impairment of structural integrity after testing to a requirement that the anti-tip device not lose its ability to support the test load because task group members thought "impairment" was too vague. A task group member and CPSC staff reiterated support for revising the standard to test the whole anti-tip device system, including attachment to the clothing storage unit and wall. CPSC staff also expressed interest in revisiting modeling to determine how the 60-pound weight in the current test method reflects the forces from child interactions with clothing storage units. The task group is close to balloting minor revisions to the test method.

**Next Steps:** Task group members plan to review the ballot draft over email. The next task group meeting has not been scheduled yet.
