Summary of Meeting:

The subcommittee met to discuss the categorized incident data dating back to 2017 to determine the adequacy of the F977-22e1 safety standard. Subcommittee members focused on the incidents related to stair falls and general falls or tip over. CPSC staff stated that the majority of incidents related to stair falls was due to the walkers not having friction pads, or other means to prevent stair falls. Subcommittee members asked which incidents were involved in recalls and would provide a list of incidents that require further investigation. CPSC staff stated they would investigate. CPSC staff also stated that the majority of tip overs were due to children pulling themselves out of the walker and/or leaning forward or to the side.

Next Steps:

The subcommittee will reconvene after the holidays in hopes of having takeaways to discuss at the Spring subcommittee meetings.
